REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that with the enactment of Law Number 43 of 2009 concerning Archives there are changes to regulations regarding the arrangement of archives, then Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 9 of 2007

regarding Guidelines for Archives Classification Patterns within the Sukoharjo Regency Government, needs to be replaced;

b. that based on the considerations as intended in letter a, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning Guidelines for Archive Classification in Regional Government Environments;

Bearing in mind: 1. Law Number 13 of 1950 concerning the Establishment of Regency Regions within the Province of Central Java as amended by Law Number 9 of 1965 concerning the Establishment of the Batang II Level Region by amending Law No. 13 of 1950 concerning the Establishment of Regency Regions within the Province of Central Java (State Gazette of 1965 Number 52, Supplement to State Gazette Number 2757);

2. Law Number 43 of 2009 concerning Archives (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2009 Number 152, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5071);

3. Law Number 23 of 2014 concerning Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5587) as amended several times, most recently by Law-

- 4. Government Regulation Number 28 of 2012 concerning Implementation of Law Number 43 of 2009 concerning Archives (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2012 Number 10, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3373);
- 5. Sukoharjo Regency Regional Regulation Number 12 of 2016 concerning the Formation and Structure of Regional Apparatus (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2016 Number 12, Supplement to Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette Number 236);

DECIDE:

To stipulate: REGULATION OF THE REGENCY OF SUKOHARJO CONCERNING GUIDELINES FOR ARCHIVES CLASSIFICATION IN THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT ENVIRONMENT.

PIG
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS
article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

- 1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
- 2. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
- 3. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of the Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
- 4. Regional Apparatus is the supporting element of the Regent and the Regional People's Representative Council in the implementation of Government Affairs which fall under the authority of the Region.
- 5. Archives classification is a pattern of organizing archives in stages from the results of the implementation of agency functions and tasks into several categories of archival information units.
- 6. Archives are records of activities or events in various forms and media in accordance with developments in information and communication technology created and accepted by state institutions, regional governments, educational institutions, companies, political organizations, community organizations and individuals in the implementation of social and national life. , and state.



- 7. Archives are matters relating to archives.
- 8. Dynamic Archives are archives that are used directly in the activities of the archive creator and are stored for a certain period of time.
- 9. Archive Creator is a party who has independence and authority in carrying out functions, duties and responsibilities in the field of dynamic archive management.
- 10. Filing is placing manuscripts into a set that is arranged systematically and logically according to the context of the activity so that they become one file because they have information relationships, similar types or similar problems of a work unit.
- 11. Archive depreciation is an activity to reduce the number of archives by transferring inactive archives from the processing unit to the archive unit, destroying archives that have no use value, and handing over static archives to archival institutions.
- 12. Archive Retention is the mandatory storage period for a type of archive.
- 13. Archives Retention Schedule, hereinafter abbreviated to JRA, is a list containing the minimum storage or retention period, types of archives, and information containing recommendations regarding whether a type of archive should be destroyed, revalued or made permanent which is used as a guideline for depreciation and preservation of archives. .

Section 2

The purpose of drafting this Regent's Regulation is as a guideline for Archive Creators in numbering letters, filing and rediscovering archives as well as preparing Archive Retention Schedules.

Article 3

This Regent's Regulation aims to create an integrated archive management system from creation, use and maintenance to archive depreciation.

CHAPTER II

CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES FOR REGIONAL GOVERNMENT ARCHIVES



Article 4

- (1) Guidelines for the Classification of Regional Government Archives in the form of codes in numerical form.
- (2) The code in numerical form as intended in paragraph (1) is prepared based on problems that reflect the main tasks and functions of Regional Apparatus.
- (3) The archive classification code as intended in paragraph (1) is the basis for numbering letters, filing and preparing the Archive Retention Schedule.

Article 5

Guidelines for Classification of Archives in Regional Government Environments, as stated in the Appendix which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

CHAPTER III
FINANCING
Article 6

Funding for the implementation of Archive Classification Guidelines in Regional Government Environment comes from the Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget.

CHAPTER IV
CLOSING
Article 7

When this Regent's Regulation comes into force, Sukoharjo Regent's Regulation Number 9 of 2007 concerning Guidelines for Classification Patterns for Sukoharjo Regency Government Archives (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2007 Number 9), is revoked and declared invalid.

Article 8



This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.

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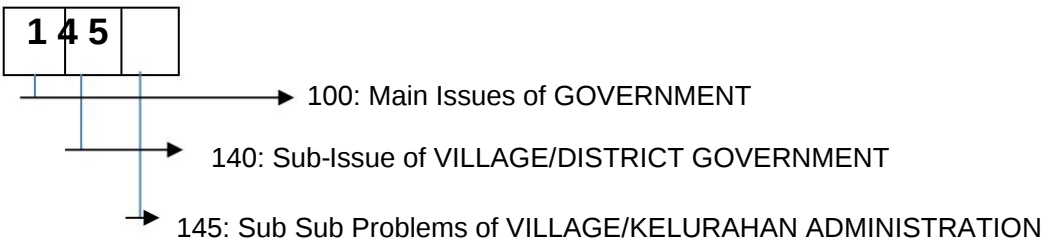
