CHANGES TO SUKOHARJO REGENCY REGULATION NUMBER 46 OF 2017
CONCERNING PUBLISHING PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS
TOURISM BUSINESS REGISTRATION SIGN

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that based on the provisions of Article 14 of the Minister of Tourism Regulation Number 18 of 2016 concerning Tourism Business Registration, it is stated that the Regent can determine the type of business and other sub-types of business for each tourism business sector in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations;

- b. that based on the considerations as intended in letter a, Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 46 of 2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Tourism Business Registration Certificates needs to be amended;
- c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning Amendments to Sukoharjo Regent's Regulation Number 46 of 2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Tourism Business Registration Certificates;

DECIDE :

To stipulate: REGENT'S REGULATION CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO SUKOHARJO
REGENT'S REGULATION NUMBER 46 OF 2017 CONCERNING
PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUING TOURISM
BUSINESS REGISTRATION SIGNS.

Article I

Several provisions in Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 46
2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Signs
List of Tourism Businesses (Regional News of Sukoharjo Regency
2017 Number 47) was amended as follows:

1. The provisions of Article 13 are amended to read as follows:

Article 13

The SPA business sector as referred to in Article 5 letter m includes the
following types of business:

- a. body care SPA; b. beauty
salon and/or bridal make-up and/or bridal or similar.

2. The provisions of Article 24 are added with 1 (one) paragraph, namely
paragraph (5), so that Article 24 reads as follows:

Article 24

- (1) The PM and PTSP Service checks the completeness of the tourism
business registration application files.
 - (2) If based on the inspection as intended in paragraph (1) it is found
that the application file is not complete, the Head of the PM and
PTSP Service shall notify the Tourism Entrepreneur in writing of the
deficiencies found.
 - (3) The inspection as intended in paragraph (1) and notification of
deficiencies as intended in paragraph (2) are completed no later
than 2 (two) working days after the application for tourism business
registration is received by the Head of the PM and PTSP Service.
 - (4) If the PM and PTSP Services do not notify in writing the deficiencies
found within 2 (two) working days after the tourism business
registration application is received, the tourism business registration
application is considered complete.
 - (5) For applications for registration of new tourism businesses, in
addition to checking files, if deemed necessary, field inspection and/
or verification can be carried out by the Licensing Technical Team.
3. The provisions of paragraph (1) of Article 20 are amended to read as follows
following:

Article 20

- (1) Applications for tourism business registration are submitted in writing by Tourism Entrepreneurs addressed to the Head of PM and PTSP Services, with the form as stated in the Attachment which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.
- (2) Submission of the application as intended in paragraph (1) is accompanied by the required documents.
- (3) Requirement documents as intended in paragraph (2) includes:
 - a. individual business:
 - 1) photocopy of Resident Identity Card;
 - 2) photocopy of NPWP;
 - and 3) technical licensing for implementing tourism businesses in accordance with statutory provisions.
 - b. business entity or legal entity:
 - 1) photocopy of Resident Identity Card;
 - 2) photocopy of the deed of establishment of the business entity and its amendments (if any changes occur);
 - 3) photocopy of NPWP;
 - and 4) technical licensing for implementing tourism businesses in accordance with statutory provisions;
- (4) Apart from the required documents as intended in paragraph (3), specifically for:
 - a. tourist attraction business, accompanied by a photocopy of proof of management rights from the owner of the tourist attraction;
 - b. tourism area business, accompanied by a photocopy of proof of land rights;
 - c. tourist transportation service business, accompanied by written information from the Tourism Entrepreneur regarding the estimated capacity of tourist transportation services expressed in the number of vehicles, ships or trains, as well as the available transportation capacity;
 - d. food and beverage service businesses, accompanied by written information from the Tourism Entrepreneur regarding the estimated capacity of food and beverage services expressed in the number of seats;
 - e. business providing accommodation, accompanied by written information from the Tourism Entrepreneur regarding the estimated capacity for providing accommodation expressed in the number of rooms and the facilities available; and
 - f. water tourism business sub-type of tourist pier, equipped with an operational permit in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.

Article II

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
