REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that agricultural machinery has a very important and strategic role in achieving agricultural development goals through handling cultivation, harvesting, post-harvest and processing of agricultural products;

b. that in order to optimize the use of agricultural machine tools and agricultural mechanization technology innovations as an effort to achieve sustainable agricultural self-sufficiency through the assistance of Agricultural Machine Tools sourced from the State Revenue and Expenditure Budget Funds, a strategy for managing agricultural machine tools is needed;

c. that based on the Regulation of the Minister of Agriculture Number 65/Permentan/OT.140/12/2006 Guidelines concerning Supervision, Procurement, Distribution and Use of Agricultural Tools and/or Machinery states that tools and/or agricultural machinery can be utilized as optimally as possible to support increased food production, it is necessary to regulate its use;

d. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a, b and c, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning Agricultural Machine Tool Brigades and Procedures for Managing Agricultural Machine Tools at the Agriculture and Fisheries Service of Sukoharjo Regency;

DECIDE :

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. The Agriculture and Fisheries Service, hereinafter referred to as the Service, is the Sukoharjo Regency Agriculture and Fisheries Service.
5. The Service Technical Implementation Unit, hereinafter abbreviated as UPTD, is the Agriculture and Fisheries Service Technical Implementation Unit Sukoharjo Regency.
6. Agricultural equipment and/or machinery, hereinafter referred to as Alsintan, is equipment operated with a motor drive or without a motor drive for food crop cultivation, horticulture, plantation and livestock activities including harvest and post-harvest activities.
7. The Machinery Brigade is a collection of agricultural machinery to carry out pre-planting, planting and harvesting activities simultaneously.
8. Farmers are individual Indonesian citizens and/or their families who carry out farming in the fields of food crops, horticulture, plantations and/or animal husbandry.
9. Farmer groups are groups of farmers/breeders/planters formed on the basis of similar interests, similar environmental conditions (social, economic, resource) and familiarity to improve and develop business member.

10. The association of farmer groups, hereinafter referred to as Gapoktan, is a collection of several farmer groups that join and work together to increase economic scale and business efficiency.
11. Agricultural Tools and Machinery Services Business, hereinafter abbreviated to UPJA, is a rural economic institution that operates in the field of services in order to optimize the use of agricultural tools and machines to gain business profits both within and outside farmer groups and Gapoktan.
12. The Water User Farmers Association, abbreviated as P3A, is an institution developed by farmers who directly benefit from water management from the network.
irrigation, surface water, reservoirs or ditch dams and ground water.
13. The next Association of Water User Farmers Associations abbreviated as GP3A is a combination of several P3A institutions that have agreed to work together to utilize irrigation water and irrigation networks in secondary block service areas, a combination of several secondary blocks, or one irrigation area with the aim of facilitating coordination patterns.
14. A cluster is a collection, group, set, or combination of certain objects that are similar on the basis of certain characteristics.

CHAPTER II

SCOPE

Section 2

The scope of this Regent's Regulation includes:

- a. Machinery Brigade;
- b. Organizational structure;
- c. Brigade Roles and Duties;
- d. Mechanism;
- e. Cooperation;
- f. Management;
- g. Monitoring and Evaluation; And
- h. Reporting.

CHAPTER III

ALSINTAN BRIGADE

Article 3

- (1) The Alsintan Brigade was formed as an organization utilizing Alsintan assistance from the government under the coordination of the Sukoharjo Regency Agriculture and Fisheries Service.

- (2) The Machinery Brigade has at least 3 (three) types of equipment and each type has a minimum of 4 (four) units.

CHAPTER IV

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

Article 4

- (1) In terms of utilizing aid, the Machinery Brigade is equipped with an organizational structure that has its own roles and duties.
- (2) The Organizational Structure of the Machinery Brigade as intended in paragraph (1) is listed in the Attachment which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

CHAPTER V

BRIGADE ROLE AND TASKS

Article 5

The role of the Brigade as intended in Article 3 is as follows:

- a. development of agricultural machinery and agricultural mechanization technology innovation; And
- b. supports the acceleration of pre-planting activities, planting to harvest in areas that lack agricultural machinery.

Article 6

The duties of the Brigade as intended in Article 3 are as follows:

- a. Facilitate agricultural machinery for pre-planting, planting and harvest activities; And
- b. optimizing the use of government-assisted machine tools central and regional.

CHAPTER VI

MECHANISM

Article 7

- (1) Communities/farmers who wish to utilize the services of the Alsintan Brigade submit an application to the management of the Alsintan Brigade.

- (2) Communities/farmers who will utilize the Alsintan Brigade services take the required Alsintan themselves to the Service Alsintan warehouse.**

CHAPTER VII

COOPERATION

Article 8

The Department of Agricultural Machinery Brigade optimizes the use of agricultural machinery by collaborating with:

- a. Agricultural and Plantation Service Agricultural and Plantation Brigade of Central Java Province;**
- b. Sukoharjo Kodim 0726 Machinery Brigade;**
- c. UPJA;**
- d. Farmers;**
- e. Association of Farmer Groups;**
- f. WUA;**
- g. GP3A; and/or**
- h. Cluster.**

CHAPTER VIII

MANAGEMENT

Article 9

The management principles of the Agricultural Machinery Brigade are implemented by the District Agriculture Service and UPTD to provide services to the community/farmers who need Alsintan for the pre-planting, planting and harvesting processes.

CHAPTER IX

FINANCING

Article 10

- (1) Financing for the Alsintan Brigade's services to the community/farmers is borne by the service user.**

- (2) The composition of financing as intended in paragraph (1) is as follows:**

- a. Fuel ranges from 20% (twenty percent);**
- b. Operator wages range from 30% (thirty percent); c.**
Alsintan mobilization is around 20% (twenty percent); and D. Care and maintenance ranges from 30% (thirty percent).

CHAPTER X

MONITORING, EVALUATION AND REPORTING**Article 11**

- (1) Monitoring and evaluation is carried out as part of coaching so that activities can run smoothly, efficiently and successfully to determine development conditions, utilization and problems that arise in the field.
- (2) Reporting must be carried out in every planting season year and equipped with pictures/photos of the use of agricultural machinery.
- (3) Pictures/photos of the use of agricultural machinery as intended in paragraph (2) include:
- a. location and area of planting resulting from the use of agricultural machinery in location;
 - b. problems encountered; and c.
- efforts that have been made as well as suggestions for improvements so that the Machinery Brigade can be better managed in the future.

CHAPTER XII

CLOSING**Article 12**

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
