REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: that to implement the provisions of Article 7 paragraph (5)
Presidential Regulation Number 97 of 2017 concerning National Household
Waste Management Policy and Strategy
And for household waste, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation
on Policy and Strategy
Directions in Household Waste Management and
Waste Similar to Household Waste;

DECIDE:

To stipulate: REGENT'S REGULATION CONCERNING REGIONAL POLICIES AND STRATEGIES IN THE MANAGEMENT OF HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND WASTE SIMILAR TO HOUSEHOLD WASTE.

PIG

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. Household Waste is waste originating from daily activities in the household which does not include feces and specific waste.
5. Waste similar to household waste is household waste originating from commercial areas, industrial areas, special areas, social facilities, public facilities, and/or other facilities.
6. Waste Source is the origin of waste generation.

7. Regional Policy and Strategy for the Management of Household Waste and Similar Types of Household Waste, hereinafter referred to as Jakstrada, is the policy direction and strategy for reducing and handling Household Waste and Types of Household Waste at the provincial and district/city levels in an integrated and sustainable manner .

CHAPTER II

JAKSTRADA DIRECTIONS

Part One

General

Section 2

- (1) Jakstrada contains:
- a. policy direction for reducing and handling household waste and household-like waste; And
 - b. strategies, targets and programs for reducing and handling household waste and similar types of household waste.
- (2) Jakstrada as intended in paragraph (1) is implemented in the period 2018 to 2025.

The second part

Policy Direction in Waste Reduction and Handling
Household and similar household waste

Article 3

- (1) Direction of waste reduction and handling policies
Household and similar household waste as intended in Article 2
paragraph (1) letter a includes improving performance in the areas of:
- a. reduction of household waste and similar household waste; And
 - b. handling household waste and household waste.
- (2) Reduction of Household Waste and Similar Waste
Household Waste as intended in paragraph (1) letter a is carried out
through:
- a. limiting the generation of household waste and
Waste Similar to Household Waste;
 - b. reuse of household waste and household waste; and/or

c. recycling of Household Waste and Garbage

A type of household waste.

(3) Handling of Household Waste and Similar Waste

Household Waste as intended in paragraph (1) letter b is carried out through:

- a. sorting;
- b. collection;
- c. transportation;
- d. processing; And
- e. final processing.

Part Three

Strategies, Programs and Targets in Reduction and
Handling of Household Waste and Similar Waste

Household waste

Article 4

(1) Strategy for reducing Household Waste and Garbage

Types of Household Waste as intended in Article 2 paragraph (1) letter b include:

- a. implementation of norms, standards, procedures and criteria in reducing household waste and similar types of household waste;
- b. strengthening coordination and cooperation between Governments Central and regional government;
- c. strengthening the commitment of executive and legislative institutions at the central and regional levels in providing budgets for reducing household waste and similar types of household waste;
- d. increasing leadership, institutional and human resource capacity in efforts to reduce household waste and similar types of household waste;
- e. formation of information systems;
- f. strengthening community involvement through communication, information and education;
- g. implementation and development of incentive and disincentive systems in reducing household waste and household waste; And
- h. strengthening the commitment of the business world through implementing producer obligations in reducing household waste and household-like waste.

(2) Strategy for handling Household Waste and Garbage

Types of Household Waste as intended in Article 2 paragraph (1) letter b include:

- a. implementation of norms, standards, procedures and criteria in reducing household waste and similar types of household waste;
- b. strengthening coordination and cooperation between Governments Central and regional government;
- c. increasing leadership, institutional and human resource capacity in handling household waste and similar types of household waste;
- d. formation of information systems;
- e. strengthening community involvement through communication, information and education;
- f. implementation and development of investment schemes, operations and maintenance;
- g. strengthening law enforcement;
- h. strengthening the involvement of the business world through partnerships with Regional Governments;
- i. application of household waste and similar household waste handling technology that is environmentally friendly and appropriate; And
- j. implementation and development of incentive and disincentive systems in handling household waste and household waste.

Article 5

(1) Targets for reducing and handling household waste and similar types of household waste as intended in Article 2 paragraph (1) letter b include:

- a. reduction of household waste and similar waste by 30% (thirty percent) of the generation of household waste and similar waste before the national policy and strategy for reducing household waste and similar waste in 2025; And
- b. The handling of household waste and similar waste is 70% (seventy percent) of the generation of household waste and similar waste before the national policy and strategy for handling household waste and similar waste in 2025.

- (2) The target for reducing and handling household waste and household waste as intended in paragraph (1) is listed in Appendix I which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

Article 6

- (1) Home Waste reduction and handling program
Household Waste and Similar Types of Household Waste as intended in Article 2 paragraph (1) letter b consist of:
- a. The waste reduction program includes limiting, reusing and recycling household waste and similar household waste; And
 - b. The waste management program includes sorting, collecting, transporting, processing and final processing of household waste and similar household waste.
- (2) The program as intended in paragraph (1) is listed in Appendix II which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

CHAPTER III

JAKSTRADA ORGANIZATION

Part One

General

Article 7

- (1) Jakstrada is in line with regional long-term development plans and regional medium-term development plans.
- (2) The preparation of Jakstrada as intended in paragraph (1) is not only guided by Jakstranas but also guided by provincial Jakstrada.

The second part

Jakstrada

Article 8

- (1) In the implementation of Jakstrada, the regent, in accordance with his/her authority, is tasked with:
- a. prepare and implement Jakstrada;
 - b. carry out monitoring and evaluation of implementation Jakstrada; And
 - c. convey the results of Jakstrada implementation to the governor at least 1 (one) time in 1 (one) year.

- (2) The Regent is responsible for procuring land, facilities and infrastructure for managing Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste in the area in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.

Article 9

- (1) Monitoring as intended in Article 8 paragraph (1) letter b is carried out to obtain information regarding the achievements in reducing and handling household waste and household waste in the region.
- (2) Monitoring as intended in paragraph (1) is coordinated by the Regent.
- (3) Achievement of reducing household waste and waste
Types of Household Waste as intended in paragraph (1) are measured using the indicators:
- a. the magnitude of the reduction in the amount of household waste and household waste-like waste per capita;
 - b. the magnitude of the increase in the amount of household waste and household waste similar to recycled household waste at waste sources; And
 - c. the magnitude of the increase in the amount of household waste and waste similar to household waste that is reused at waste sources.
- (4) Achievements in handling household waste and waste
Types of Household Waste as intended in paragraph (1) are measured using the indicators:
- a. the amount of increase in the amount of Household Waste and Waste Similar to Household Waste which is separated into Waste Sources;
 - b. the magnitude of the reduction in the amount of household waste and similar types of household waste transported to the final processing site;
 - c. the amount of increase in the amount of household waste and similar household waste transported to the processing center for household waste and similar household waste to become raw materials and/or energy sources;
 - d. the magnitude of the increase in the amount of household waste and similar types of household waste processed into raw materials;
 - e. the magnitude of the increase in the amount of household waste and similar types of household waste that is utilized as an energy source; And

- f. the amount of reduction in the amount of household waste and similar types of household waste processed at the final processing site.
- (5) The monitoring results as intended in paragraph (3) and paragraph (4) are prepared in the form of a Jakstrada report.
- (6) The Jakstrada report as intended in paragraph (5) is evaluated by the regent as intended in Article 9 paragraph (1) letter b.
- (7) The evaluation as intended in paragraph (6) is coordinated by the governor through:
- d. comparison between achievements and targets planning; And
 - e. identification and resolution of implementation obstacles.
- (8) The evaluation results are used as a basis for Jakstrada improvements.

CHAPTER IV

FUNDING

Article 10

Funding for the implementation of Jakstrada can come from the State Revenue and Expenditure Budget, Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget and other legal funding sources in accordance with statutory provisions.

CHAPTER V

CLOSING

Article 11

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation. So that everyone knows, order this Regent's Regulation to be placed in the Regional News of Sukoharjo Regency.
