BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that in order to develop dynamic conditions in empowering Village communities, as well as mobilizing and developing participation, mutual cooperation and self-reliance of Village communities in development, it is necessary to establish Village Community Institutions;

b. that with the enactment of Minister of Home Affairs Regulation Number 18 of 2018 concerning Village Community Institutions and Village Traditional Institutions it is necessary to establish policies related to Village Community Institutions;

c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning Village Community Institutions;

Bearing in mind: 1. Law Number 13 of 1950 concerning the Establishment of Regency Areas within the Province of Central Java;

2. Law Number 25 of 2004 concerning the National Development Planning System (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2004 Number 104, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4421);

3. Law Number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 7, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5495) as amended by Law Number 11 of 2020 concerning Job Creation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);

4. Law Number 23 of 2014 concerning Regional Government (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 244, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5587) as amended several times, most recently by Law Number 11 of 2020 concerning Job Creation

(State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia 2020 Number 245, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6573);

5. Government Regulation Number 43 of 2014 concerning Implementing Regulations of Law Number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 123, Supplement to State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5539) as amended several times, most recently by Government Regulation Number 11 of the Year 2019 concerning the second amendment to Government Regulation Number 43 of 2014 concerning Implementing Regulations of Law Number 6 of 2014 concerning Villages (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2019 Number 41, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 6321);

6. Presidential Regulation Number 99 of 2017 concerning the Family Empowerment and Welfare Movement (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 226);

7. Minister of Home Affairs Regulation Number 18 of 2018 concerning Village Community Institutions and Village Traditional Institutions (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 569);

DECIDE:

To stipulate: REGULATIONS OF THE VILLAGE ABOUT INSTITUTION
COMMUNITY REGENT.

PIG
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.

3. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of the Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
4. The sub-district head is the sub-district leader who is under and responsible to the Regent through the Regional Secretary.
5. A village is a legal community unit that has territorial boundaries that has the authority to regulate and manage government affairs, the interests of local communities based on community initiatives, origin rights, and/or traditional rights that are recognized and respected in the government system of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.
6. Village Government is the administration of government affairs and the interests of local communities in the government system of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.
7. Village Government is the Village Head assisted by Village officials as an element of Village Government administration.
8. Village Community Institutions, hereinafter abbreviated to LKD, are a forum for community participation, as partners of the Village Government, participating in the implementation of planning, development, and improving village community services.
9. The Village Head is a Village Government official who has the authority, duties and obligations to organize his village household and carry out the duties of the Government and Regional Government.
10. Village Consultative Body, hereinafter abbreviated as BPD, is an institution that carries out government functions whose members are representatives of the Village population based on regional representation and are determined democratically.
11. Community Empowerment Institution, hereinafter abbreviated to LPM, is an institution or forum formed on the initiative of the community as a partner of the Village Government in accommodating and realizing the aspirations and needs of the community in the field of development.
12. Integrated Service Post, hereinafter referred to as Posyandu, is a community institution that assists the Village Head in improving Village community health services.

13. Family Empowerment and Welfare, hereinafter abbreviated to PKK, is one of the Village community institutions that accommodates community participation in the field of empowering family welfare at the level of the community unit and neighborhood level which coordinates the dasawisma group.
 or other
14. Family Empowerment and Welfare Mobilization Team, hereinafter abbreviated as TP PKK, is a movement in community development that grows from, by, and for the community, towards the realization of a family that has faith and devotion to God Almighty, has noble and virtuous character, is healthy and prosperous. , progress and independence, gender equality and justice, as well as legal and environmental awareness. Community institutions as working partners of the government and other community organizations, which function as facilitators, planners, implementers, controllers and mobilizers at each level of government for the implementation of the PKK program.
15. The Family Empowerment and Welfare Movement, hereinafter referred to as the PKK Movement, is a National Movement in the development of society that grows from below and is managed from, by and for the community towards the realization of a family that believes in and is devoted to God Almighty, has noble and virtuous morals , healthy, prosperous, advanced and independent, gender equality and justice as well as legal and environmental awareness.
16. Karang Taruna is a social institution which is a forum for the development of the young generation which grows and develops on the basis of awareness and a sense of social responsibility from, by and for the community, especially the young generation in village areas or equivalent traditional communities and especially functionally fostered and developed by the Department of Social Affairs .
17. Rukun Tetangga, hereinafter abbreviated to RT, is an institution formed through community deliberation determined by the Village Government.
18. Rukun Warga, hereinafter abbreviated as RW, is part of the work area of the Village Government and is an institution formed through deliberation of the RT management in its work area determined by the Village Government.
19. Village Development is an effort to improve the quality of life and life for the greatest welfare of the Village community.
20. Village Regulations are statutory regulations stipulated by the Village Head after being discussed and agreed upon with the BPD.

CHAPTER II
FORMATION AND DETERMINATION

Part One
Formation

Section 2

- (1) LKD is formed on the initiative of the Village Government and the community.
- (2) Establishment of LKD as intended in paragraph (1) by fulfilling the requirements:
 - a. based on Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia;
 - b. domiciled in the local village;
 - c. its existence is useful and needed villagers;
 - d. have permanent management;
 - e. has a permanent secretariat; and f. not affiliated with any political party.

Article 3

- (1) Further provisions regarding the Establishment of LKD as intended in Article 2 are regulated by Village Regulations.
- (2) The Village Regulations as intended in paragraph (1) contain at least:
 - a. type of LKD formed;
 - b. purpose and objectives;
 - c. membership and management structure;
 - d. period of service of management;
 - e. duties, functions and obligations; And
 - f. dismissal and replacement of management.

The second part
Determination

Article 4

LKD is determined by the Village Head in the Village Head Decree.

CHAPTER III
JOB AND FUNCTION

Article 5

- (1) LKD is tasked with:
 - a. empowering village communities;

- b. participate in planning and implementation development; And
 - c. improve village community services.
- (2) In carrying out the tasks as intended in paragraph (1) letter b, LKD proposes programs and activities to the Village Government.

Article 6

In carrying out the duties as referred to in Article 5, LKD has the following functions:

- a. accommodate and channel community aspirations;
- b. instill and foster a sense of community unity and integrity;
- c. improve the quality and speed up Village Government services to Village communities;
- d. prepare plans, implement, control, preserve and develop development results participatively;
- e. grow, develop and mobilize community initiative, participation, self-help and mutual cooperation;
- f. improving family welfare; And
- g. improve the quality of human resources.

CHAPTER IV TYPE

Part One General

Article 7

- (1) Types of LKD at least include:
- a. RT;
 - b. RW;
 - c. TP PKK;
 - d. Youth organization;
 - e. Integrated Healthcare Center; And
 - f. LPM.
- (2) The Village Government and Village community can form LKD other than as intended in paragraph (1) in accordance with developments and needs.
- (3) Further provisions regarding the type of LKD as intended in paragraph (1) are stipulated in the Village Regulation.

Article 8

- (1) The Village Government may form LKD other than the type referred to in Article 7 paragraph (1) and must consider the following:
- a. village needs;
 - b. social and cultural society; c. geographical location of the village; And
 - d. village characteristics.
- (2) The formation of LKD as intended in paragraph (1) must be validated by the regional government in order to issue recommendations.

Article 9

LKD administrators are selected by deliberation from community members who have the will, ability and concern for community empowerment.

The second part
RT

Article 10

The RT as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter a is formed with the provisions of at least 30 (thirty) Head of Family and a maximum of 100 (one hundred) Heads of Family.

Article 11

- (1) The RT management consists of:
- a. chairman;
 - b. secretary;
 - c. treasurer; And
 - d. fields according to needs.
- (2) Further provisions regarding RT administrators as intended in paragraph (1) is determined by Village Head Decree.
- (3) The RT management as intended in paragraph (1) holds office for 5 (five) years from the date of appointment.
- (4) RT administrators as referred to in paragraph (1) can serve a maximum of 2 (two) consecutive or non-consecutive terms of office.
- (5) RT administrators are prohibited from holding concurrent positions in other LKDs and are prohibited from being members of a political party.

Article 12

The procedures for forming RT administrators are as follows:

- a. RT administrator candidates are proposed by the RT residents concerned;
- b. the election of RT administrators is carried out by deliberation and/or by voting by the RT residents concerned in a specially held meeting, which is attended and chaired by the Village Head or other appointed village officials; And
- c. The composition and names of the RT management elected at the special meeting as intended in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

Part Three
RW

Article 13

The RW as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter b is formed with provisions consisting of at least 2 (two) RT.

Article 14

- (1) The RW management consists of:
 - a. chairman;
 - b. secretary;
 - c. treasurer; And
 - d. fields according to needs.
- (2) Further provisions regarding RW administrators as intended in paragraph (1) is determined by Village Head Decree.
- (3) The RW administrator as referred to in paragraph (1) holds office for 5 (five) years from the date of appointment.
- (4) RW administrators as referred to in paragraph (1) can serve a maximum of 2 (two) consecutive or non-consecutive terms of office.
- (5) RW administrators are prohibited from holding concurrent positions in other LKDs and are prohibited from being members of a political party.

Article 15

The procedures for forming RW administrators are as follows:

- a. At least 2 (two) RW administrator candidates are proposed RT administrators who are different from the RW concerned;

- b. the election of RW administrators is carried out by deliberation and/ or by voting by several RT administrators who are different from the RW concerned in a specially held meeting, which is attended and chaired by the Village Head or other appointed Village apparatus;
And
- c. The composition and names of the RW management elected at the special meeting as referred to in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

Part Four
TP PKK

Article 16

- (1) Village PKK TP as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter c consists of:
 - a. the chairman is held by the wife/husband of the Village Head;
 - b. the deputy chairman is held by the wife/husband of the Village Secretary;
 - c. secretary;
 - d. treasurer; And
 - e. working group I, working group II, working group III and working group IV.
- (2) In the event that the Village Head as intended in paragraph (1) does not have or does not have a wife/husband, then the Head of the TP The PKK is held by the wife/husband of the Village Secretary
- (3) In the event that the Village Secretary as referred to in paragraph (1) does not have or does not have a wife/husband, the Chair of the TP PKK is held by the wife/husband of another Village Apparatus.
- (4) The wife/husband of another Village Apparatus as intended in paragraph (3) is appointed by the Village Head.
- (5) Working group as intended in paragraph (1) letter e consists of:
 - a. working group I as program manager:
 - 1. appreciation and practice of Pancasila; And
 - 2. mutual cooperation.
 - b. working group II as program manager:
 - 1. education and skills; And
 - 2. development of cooperative life.
 - c. working group III as program manager:
 - 1. food; 2. clothing; And
 - 3. housing and household management.
 - d. working group IV as program manager:
 - 1. health;

2. environmental sustainability; And

3. healthy planning.

(6) The working group as intended in paragraph (5) consists of:

- a. chairman;
- b. Vice Chairman;
- c. secretary; And
- d. member.

(7) The composition of the Village TP PKK management as referred to in paragraph (1) is determined by the Village Head's Decree.

(8) The Village Head's decision as referred to in paragraph (7) contains at least details of the duties and functions of the Village TP PKK.

Article 17

- (1) The chairman of the Village TP PKK is appointed and appointed by the chairman of the District TP PKK and confirmed by the Village Head.
- (2) The Village TP PKK Management is determined and appointed by the Village Head.

Article 18

- (1) In implementing TP PKK programs and activities
The village is facilitated by the supervisor.
- (2) The chairman of the Village TP PKK supervisor as referred to in paragraph (1) is the Village Head according to his authority.
- (3) The supervisor as intended in paragraph (1), namely
Village Government, BPD and Village community leaders.

Article 19

- (1) The period of service for the Village TP PKK chairman is from the inauguration until the end of the Village Head's term of office.
- (2) The period of service for the Village TP PKK administrator is 6 (six) years starting from the inauguration.

Article 20

The procedures for forming TP PKK administrators are as follows:

- a. Candidates for TP PKK administrators are proposed by the relevant Village community leaders;
- b. the election of TP PKK administrators is carried out by deliberation in a specially held meeting and chaired by the Village Head;
- c. the special meeting as intended in letter b is attended by the relevant Village community leaders; And

- d. the composition and names of the management elected at the special meeting as referred to in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

Part Five
Youth organization

Article 21

- (1) The Karang Taruna management consists of:
- a. chairman;
 - b. secretary;
 - c. treasurer; And
 - d. fields according to needs.
- (2) Further provisions regarding Karang Taruna administrators as intended in paragraph (1) is determined by Village Head Decree.
- (3) The Karang Taruna management as referred to in paragraph (1) serves for 5 (five) years starting from the date of appointment.
- (4) The Karang Taruna management as referred to in paragraph (1) can serve a maximum of 2 (two) consecutive or non-consecutive terms of office.
- (5) Karang Taruna administrators are prohibited from holding concurrent positions in other LKDs and are prohibited from being members of a political party.

Article 22

The procedures for forming Karang Taruna management are as follows:

- a. Candidates for Karang Taruna management are proposed by the relevant Village community leaders;
- b. the election of Karang Taruna management is carried out by deliberation in a specially held meeting and chaired by the Village Head;
- c. the special meeting as intended in letter b is attended by the relevant Village community leaders; And
- d. the composition and names of the management elected at the special meeting as referred to in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

Part Six

Integrated Healthcare Center

Article 23

- (1) Posyandu membership consists of:
- a. chairman;

- b. secretary;
 - c. treasurer; And
 - d. member.
- (2) Posyandu membership as referred to in paragraph (1) is determined by Village Head Decree.
- (3) Posyandu membership as intended in paragraph (1) is valid for 5 (five) years from the date of appointment.
- (4) Posyandu members as referred to in paragraph (1) can serve a maximum of 2 (two) consecutive or non-consecutive terms of office.
- join in.
- (5) Posyandu members are prohibited from holding concurrent positions in other LKDs and are prohibited from being a member of a political party.

Article 24

The procedures for forming Posyandu administrators are as follows:

- a. Candidates for Posyandu administrators are proposed by the relevant Village community leaders;
- b. the election of Posyandu administrators is carried out by deliberation in a specially held meeting and chaired by the Village Head;
- c. the special meeting as intended in letter b is attended by the relevant Village community leaders; And
- d. the composition and names of the management elected at the special meeting as referred to in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

Part Seven LPM

Article 25

- (1) The LPM management consists of:
- a. chairman;
 - b. secretary;
 - c. treasurer; And
 - d. fields according to needs.
- (2) Further provisions regarding LPM administrators as intended in paragraph (1) is determined by Village Head Decree.
- (3) The LPM management as referred to in paragraph (1) serves for 5 (five) years starting from the date of appointment.

- (4) LPM administrators as referred to in paragraph (1) can serve a maximum of 2 (two) consecutive or non-consecutive terms of office.
- (5) LPM administrators are prohibited from holding concurrent positions in other LKDs and are prohibited from being members of a political party.

Article 26

The procedures for forming LPM management are as follows:

- a. Candidates for LPM management are proposed by relevant village community leaders;
- b. the election of LPM administrators is carried out by deliberation in a specially held meeting and chaired by the Village Head;
- c. the special meeting as intended in letter b is attended by the relevant village community leaders;
- d. the composition and names of the management elected at the special meeting as referred to in letter b are determined by the Village Head's Decree.

CHAPTER V

TASK

Article 27

- (1) RT and RW as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letters a and b are responsible for:
 - a. assist the Village Head in the field of government services; b. assist the Village Headin providing population data and permits; And
 - c. carry out other tasks assigned by the Head Village.
- (2) TP PKK as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter c, is tasked with assisting the Village Head in implementing family welfare empowerment.
- (3) Karang Taruna as referred to in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter d, is tasked with assisting the Village Head in overcoming social welfare problems and developing the younger generation.
- (4) Posyandu as intended in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter e is tasked with assisting the Village Head in improving Village community health services.
- (5) LPM as referred to in Article 7 paragraph (1) letter f, is tasked with assisting the Village Head in absorbing community aspirations regarding village development planning and mobilizing the community in implementing village development through mutual cooperation.

CHAPTER VI
WORK RELATIONSHIP

Article 28

- (1) LKD's working relationship with the Village Government is of a nature partnership.
- (2) The working relationship between LKD and BPD is consultative.
- (3) LKD's working relationship with other Community Institutions in the Village is coordinative.

CHAPTER VII
TERMINATION

Article 29

- (1) The LKD management resigns because:
 - a. die;
 - b. resign; and/or
 - c. dismissed.
- (2) LKD administrators are dismissed as intended in paragraph (1) letter c, if:
 - a. end of management period;
 - b. unable to carry out duties for 3 (three) consecutive months without any information;
And
 - c. declared guilty based on a court decision that has permanent legal force for committing a criminal act.

CHAPTER VIII
ACCOUNTABILITY

Article 30

The Chair of the LKD in carrying out his duties is responsible to the Village Head.

CHAPTER IX
WORKING PROCEDURE

Article 31

In carrying out their duties, LKD applies the principles of coordination, integration and synchronization both within their respective environments and in the relationship between LKD and the Village Government.

Article 32

In carrying out their duties, the LKD Chair applies the principles of planning, organizing, monitoring, evaluating and reporting according to their respective areas of duty.

CHAPTER X
GUIDANCE AND SUPERVISION

Article 33

- (1) The Regent carries out guidance and supervision of formation, empowerment and utilization of LKD as a partner of the Village Government in its area.
- (2) The sub-district head carries out guidance and supervision of the formation, empowerment and utilization of LKD as a partner of the Village Government in the Village.
- (3) In carrying out guidance and supervision as intended in paragraph (1), the Regent may delegate his authority to Regional Apparatus in charge of Community and Village Empowerment.

CHAPTER XI
TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Article 34

LKDs that were established before this Regent's Regulation came into effect, are still recognized as LKD as long as they do not conflict with this Regent's Regulation.

CHAPTER XII
CLOSING

Article 35

LKDs that do not comply with the provisions in this Regent's Regulation are required to conform to this Regent's Regulation within a maximum of 1 (one) year.

Article 36

When this Regent's Regulation comes into force, Sukoharjo Regent's Regulation Number 4 of 2008 concerning Guidelines for the Implementation of Sukoharjo Regency Regional Regulation Number 11 of 2007 concerning Village Community Institutions (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2008 Number 4) is revoked and declared invalid.

Article 37

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
