**REGENT SUKOHARJO,**

- Considering:**
- a. that the Regional Public Company for Drinking Water Tirta Makmur is one of the regionally owned business entities that operates in the field of providing clean water;**
  - b. that in order to maintain the continuity of the carrying capacity and function of groundwater, it is necessary to utilize the water of the Regional Public Company for Drinking Water Tirta Makmur as an alternative to fulfill water needs for business activities;**
  - c. that based on the provisions of Article 12 letter c of the Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources Regulation Number 15 of 2012 concerning Saving the Use of Ground Water, it is necessary to carry out ground water conservation efforts through the use of water from the Regional Public Company for Drinking Water Tirta Makmur;**
  - d. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a, b and c, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation on Company Water Use Tirta Makmur Regional General Drinking Water for Business Activities;**

**Establish: REGENT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE USE OF TIRTA MAKMUR REGIONAL PUBLIC COMPANY WATER FOR BUSINESS ACTIVITIES.**

**GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

**article 1**

**In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:**

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. Natural resource conservation is the management of natural resources to ensure their wise use and continued availability while maintaining and improving their quality, value and diversity.
5. Groundwater is water contained in layers soil or rock below the ground surface.
6. Tirta Makmur Regional Public Company for Drinking Water, hereinafter referred to as Perumda Air Drinking Tirta Makmur, is the Regional Public Company for Drinking Water of Sukoharjo Regency which is a Regional Public Company which operates in the field of drinking water services.

- 7. Micro Business is a productive business owned by an individual and/or individual business entity that meets the criteria for Micro Business as regulated in the Law.**
- 8. Small businesses are productive economic businesses that stand alone, carried out by individuals or business entities that are not subsidiaries or branches of companies that are owned, controlled, or are part, either directly or indirectly, of medium or large businesses that meet Small Business criteria as intended in this Law.**
- 9. Medium Business is a productive economic business that stands alone, which is carried out by an individual or business entity which is not a subsidiary or branch of a company that is owned, controlled, or is part either directly or indirectly with a Small Business or Large Business with total assets net or annual sales proceeds as regulated in this Law.**
- 10. Large Businesses are productive economic businesses carried out by business entities with net assets or annual sales proceeds greater than Medium Businesses, which include state-owned or private national businesses, joint ventures, and foreign businesses carrying out economic activities in Indonesia.**
- 11. The Business World is Micro Businesses, Small Businesses, Medium Businesses and Large Businesses that carry out economic activities in Indonesia and are domiciled in Indonesia.**
- 12. An individual is an individual who owns and runs a productive business that is continuously aimed at obtaining profit or gain.**
- 13. Business Entity is any form of state/regional or privately owned legal entity that employs workers/laborers by paying wages or other forms of remuneration.**
- 14. Industry is all forms of economic activity that manage raw materials and/or utilize industrial resources, so that they can produce goods that have added value or higher benefits, including industrial services.**
- 15. Commerce or also known as Trade is a system of activities related to transactions of Goods and/or Services within the country and beyond national borders with the aim of transferring rights to Goods and/or Services to obtain rewards or compensation.**

## Section 2

- (1) The purpose of drafting this Regent's Regulation is as a manifestation of the role of the Regional Government through Perumda Air Minum Tirta Makmur in order to share responsibility for maintaining the continued existence, carrying capacity and function of groundwater in order to support the conservation of water resources.
- (2) The purpose of drafting this Regent's Regulation is to  
Optimizing water use by Perumda Air Minum Tirta Makmur for business activities.

### CHAPTER II

#### USE OF PERUMDA WATER TIRTA MAKMUR DRINKING WATER

##### Article 3

Every business activity in areas covered by the Tirta Makmur Drinking Water Perumda network is required to use water from the Tirta Makmur Drinking Water Perumda network.

##### Article 4

The obligation to use water from Perumda Air Drinking Tirta Makmur by individuals or business entities as intended in Article 3 is stated in the Environmental Document.

### CHAPTER III

#### TARGETED USE

##### Article 5

- (1) The targets for using Perumda Air Minum Tirta Makmur water for business activities are aimed at:
- a. Industry
  - b. Commerce consisting of
    1. large commerce, including:
      - a) State-Owned Enterprises, Owned Enterprises Regional, service companies;
      - b) type A and type B hospitals; c) supermarkets, malls; d) factory; e) private swimming pool;
      - f) cinema hall;
      - g) dealer, distribution agent;
      - h) private banks; And
      - i) 3 star, 4 star and 5 star hotels.

2. small commerce,  
 including: a)  
 permanent kiosks; b) business cooperatives;  
 c) legal aid institutions;  
 d) acupuncture practice, dental specialist;  
 e) salon;  
 f) budget hotels;  
 g) 1 star and 2 star hotels;  
 h) doctor's practice;  
 i) restaurant/catering house;  
 j) maternity clinic; k)  
 warehouse;  
 l) shophouse/small  
 supermarket; m) private offices, trading  
 services; n)  
 pharmacy; and o) type C and type D hospitals.

- (2) The targets as intended in paragraph (1) are excluded for micro business activities and business activities that the Tirta Makmur Drinking Water Company is not yet able to serve.

#### CHAPTER IV

### USAGE ALLOCATION

#### Article 6

- (1) Individuals or business entities carrying out business activities are required to use water from Perumda Air Minum Tirta Prosper with the following conditions:
- a. Industry accounts for at least 25% (twenty five percent) of overall water use;
  - b. Commerce consists of:
    1. Large trade accounts for at least 50% (fifty percent) of overall water use; And
    2. Small businesses account for at least 50% (fifty percent) of overall water use.
- (2) The overall use as intended in paragraph (1) is calculated from the average cubic capacity of water use per month in 1 (one) year.

- (3) In the case of new business activities, the average amount of cubic capacity used is based on the estimated water use per month.

CHAPTER V

**GUIDANCE AND SUPERVISION**

**Article 7**

- (1) The Regent carries out guidance and supervision of the Tirta Makmur Regional Public Company's Water Use for Business Activities.
- (2) Guidance and Supervision as intended in paragraph (1) is carried out by a Team determined by Regent's Decree.

CHAPTER VI

**ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTIONS**

**Article 8**

- (1) Persons in charge of businesses who violate the provisions as intended in Article 5 are subject to sanctions administrative form:
- a. Written warning;
  - b. Government coercion;
  - c. Suspension of environmental permits; and
  - D. Revocation of environmental permits.
- (2) The imposition of administrative sanctions as intended in paragraph (1) is carried out by the Regent through the Environmental Service.

CHAPTER VII

**TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS**

**Article 9**

Persons in charge of businesses that already have an environmental permit prior to the issuance of this Regent's Regulation must use the water of the Tirta Makmur Regional Public Drinking Water Company. adjust to the provisions in this Regent's Regulation within a maximum period of 12 (twelve) months after this Regent's Regulation comes into force.

CHAPTER VIII

**CLOSING**

**Article 10**

**This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.**

**So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.**
