Weigh

- : a. that to provide convenience in sharing use and dissemination of geospatial information, it is necessary to optimize the geospatial information network by involving all stakeholders in the field of geospatial information in Sukoharjo Regency;
- b. that based on the provisions of Article 23 of Law Number 4 of 2011 concerning Geospatial Information, and Article 14 of Government Regulation Number 45 of 2021 concerning the Implementation of Geospatial Information, states that the Regional Government organizes Geospatial Information based on its duties, functions and authority in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations;
- c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to determine the Regent regarding the Implementation of Geospatial Information Regulation,

DECIDE:

To stipulate: REGENT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATION OF GEOSPATIAL INFORMATION.

PIG

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

- In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:
1. Region is Sukoharjo Regency.
  2. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
  3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
  4. Regional Apparatus is the supporting element of the Regent and the Regional People's Representative Council in administering government affairs which fall under the authority of the Region.

5. The Regional Planning, Research and Development Agency, hereinafter abbreviated to Bappelbangda, is the Regional Planning, Research and Development Agency of Sukoharjo Regency.
6. The Communication and Informatics Service, hereinafter abbreviated as Diskominfo, is the Sukoharjo Regency Communication and Informatics Service.
7. Spatial is the spatial aspect of an object or event which includes its location, location and position.
8. Geospatial or terrestrial space is a spatial aspect that shows the location, location and position of an object or event that is under, on or above the earth's surface expressed in a certain coordinate system.
9. Geospatial data, hereinafter abbreviated as DG, is data about geographic location, dimensions, or size, and/or characteristics of natural and/or man-made objects located under, on, or above the surface of the earth.
10. Geospatial Information, hereinafter abbreviated as IG, is DG that has been processed so that it can be used as a tool in formulating policies, making decisions, and/or implementing activities related to terrestrial space.
11. Basic Geospatial Information, hereinafter abbreviated to IGD, is IG which contains objects that can be seen directly or measured from physical appearances on the surface of the earth and which do not change over a relatively long time.
12. Thematic Geospatial Information, hereinafter abbreviated to IGT, is IG which describes one or more specific themes made in reference to IGD.
13. IG implementation is the creation of IG which is carried out through the activities of collecting DG, processing DG and IG, storing DG and IG, securing DG and IG, disseminating DG and IG, and using IG.

14. The National Geospatial Information Network, hereinafter referred to as the IGN Network, is a system for organizing GI management in a joint, orderly, measurable, integrated, sustainable and efficient manner.
15. Network Nodes are responsible institutions responsible for organizing the collection, maintenance, updating, exchange and dissemination of certain DG and IG.
16. Network Node Liaison is an institution that organizes the integration of Network Nodes nationally.
17. Metadata is data that explains the history and characteristics of DG and IG.
18. Everyone is an individual, group of people, or business entity.

## Section 2

- (1) The purpose of drafting this Regent's Regulation is to realize quality development planning and effective development control, through the management and utilization of geospatial data and information that is accurate, up-to-date, integrated, complete, accountable, dynamic, reliable, valid, easily accessible and sustainable.
- (2) The purpose of drafting this Regent's Regulation is:
  - a. have an accurate, complete and integrated geospatial development database;
  - b. produce appropriate, actual, quality and accountable development policy analysis for regions and stakeholders;
  - c. facilitating the collection and exchange of spatial data by Regional Apparatus; d. facilitating the dissemination of spatial data between Regional Apparatus and the community; e. produce measurable and comprehensive development plans; and f. realizing reliable development control, monitoring, evaluation and reporting.

## SCOPE

### Article 3

The scope of this Regent's Regulation includes:

- a. IG networks and Network Nodes;
- b. DG management;
- c. DG collection;
- d. DG and IG processing;
- e. storage and security of DG and IG;
- f. dissemination of DG and IG;
- g. use of IG;
- h. coordination and synchronization;
- i. cooperation; And
- j. participation of society and the business world.

#### CHAPTER III

### IG NETWORKS AND NETWORK NODES

#### Article 4

- (1) The Regional IG Network includes the Regional Government which serves as a Network Node.
- (2) The Network Node as referred to in paragraph (1) is tasked with organizing the Regional IG based on its function, duties and authority in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.
- (3) To carry out Network Node duties as intended in paragraph (2), the Regent determines:
  - a. the work unit that carries out the collection, processing and use of DG and IG, namely Bappelbangda; And
  - b. The work unit that carries out storage, security and dissemination of DG and IG is Diskominfo.
- (4) Storage as intended in paragraph (3) letter b includes IG that is ready for dissemination.

#### Article 5

Apart from carrying out storage, security and dissemination of DG and IG, the work unit as intended in Article 4 paragraph (3) letter b, is tasked with:

- a. do dissemination IG which is held through the IGN network in accordance with standard operational procedures and technical guidelines for IG dissemination;
- b. building, continuity maintain, and ensure of implementation; system access The IG  
And
- c. coordinating with work units in storing, securing and disseminating IG and its metadata.

CHAPTER IV

MANAGEMENT DG

Part One

Data Type

Article 6

(1) Regional Development DG consists of:

- a. ER; And
- b. IGT.

(2) Apart from the Regional Development DG as intended in paragraph (1), data managed by the Regional Government is grouped into:

- a. publishable data; And
- b. confidential data.

(3) Confidential data as intended in paragraph (2) letter b is information that is excluded as regulated in Law Number 14 of 2008 concerning Openness of Public Information.

The second part

Data source

Article 7

(1) The IGD as intended in Article 6 paragraph (1) letter a is obtained from Bappelbangda.

(2) IGT as intended in Article 6 paragraph (1) letter b is obtained from Regional Apparatus,

ministries/agencies and other sources.

### Part Three

#### Manager

#### Article 8

- (1) Regional Government as a Network Node carries out management and analysis of Regional Development DG.
- (2) Management and analysis of Regional Development DG (1), as intended in the paragraph is coordinated by Bappelbangda.
- (3) Each Regional Apparatus manages a complete DG, actual, valid and accountable.
- (4) Each Regional Apparatus submits a copy of the DG it manages to Bappelbangda in order to build One Regional Development DG.
- (5) In coordinating the management of DG as intended in paragraph (2), Bappelbangda acts as the entry point for DG acquisition.

#### CHAPTER V

### DG COLLECTION

#### Article 9

- (1) DG collection as intended in Article 3 letter c is a process or method for obtaining DG which is carried out using DG collection methods and instruments.
- (2) DG as intended in paragraph (1) consists of:
  - a. Basic DG; And
  - b. Thematic DG.
- (3) Collection of DG as intended in paragraph (1) carried out by Regional Apparatus.
- (4) The Regional Apparatus responsible for DG is as listed in the Attachment which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

#### Article 10

- (1) Collection of DG as intended in Article

9 paragraph (1) is carried out

by: a. surveys using measuring and/or recording instrumentation, carried out on land, on water vehicles, on air vehicles, and/or on space vehicles;

b. enumeration; and/or c.

other ways in accordance with the development of science knowledge and technology.

(2) DG collection as intended in paragraph (1) must be carried out in accordance with standards which include: a. geospatial reference

systems; and b. types, definitions, criteria and data formats.

#### Article 11

(1) DG collection must obtain permission if: a. it is carried out in a prohibited area; or

b. has the potential to cause danger.

(2) The permit as intended in paragraph (1) is intended to guarantee safety and security for data collectors and the public.

#### Article 12

(1) The Regional Government, when collecting DG in an area, must notify the owner, authority or beneficiary of the area.

(2) The owner, authority or beneficiary of the area as intended in paragraph (1) can refuse and/or suggest that data collection activities be carried out at another time only if there are things in the area that could endanger the data collector.

(3) Rejection and/or suggestions as referred to in paragraph (2) must be submitted no later than 7 (seven) days after the notification is submitted by the data collector.

(4) Data collectors can continue activities in the area if the owner, authority, or

the beneficiary from the area does not provide an answer within the 7 (seven) day period as intended in paragraph (3).

CHAPTER VI

DG AND IG PROCESSING

Article 13

DG and IG processing as intended in Article 3 letter d is a process or method of processing data and IG.

Article 14

DG and IG processing includes DG processing and IG presentation.

Article 15

DG processing as intended in Article 14 must be carried out in accordance with standards that include:

- a. a projection system and coordinate system that can clearly and definitely be transformed into a national standard coordinate system; And
- b. formats, databases, and metadata that can be with easy to integrate with other IG.

Article 16

Presentation of IG as intended in Article 14 carried out in the form:

- a. coordinate information table; b.
- printed maps; And
- c. digital map.

Article 17

Presentation of IG in the form of printed maps and digital maps as intended in Article 16 letter b and letter c must use a scale determined based on the level of accuracy of the data source and the purpose of using the GI.

CHAPTER VII

## STORAGE AND SECURITY OF DG AND IG

### Article 18

Storage and security of DG and IG as intended in Article 3 letter e is a way of placing DG and IG in a safe place and not damaged or lost to ensure the availability of IG.

## CHAPTER VIII

## DISTRIBUTION OF DG AND IG

### Article 19

Dissemination of DG and IG as intended in Article 3 letter f is an activity providing access, distribution and exchange of DG and IG which can be carried out using electronic media and print media.

### Article 20

- (1) The IG created by the Regional Government is of a nature open.
- (2) Certain GIs created by the Regional Government may be closed in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.

### Article 21

- (1) The Regional IG Network is implemented by the Regional Government and integrated with the central IG network.
- (2) Provisions regarding IG networks are implemented in accordance with statutory provisions.

## CHAPTER IX

## IG USE

### Article 22

Use of GI as intended in Article 3 letter g is an activity to obtain benefits, either directly or indirectly.

### Article 23

Every person who makes a derivative product of an IG

with the intention of buying and selling, permission must be obtained from the IG owner.

#### Article 24

Regional Governments must use accurate IG in decision making and/or determining policies related to terrestrial space.

### CHAPTER X

#### COORDINATION AND SYNCHRONIZATION

#### Article 25

Bappelbangda carries out coordination and synchronization management of Regional Development DG with Regional Apparatus.

#### Article 26

- (1) For integrated management of DG development in the Region, a Data Forum was formed as a forum DG communication for cross-sector development.
- (2) The Data Forum as intended in paragraph (1), is carried out at least 1 (one) time in 1 (one) year to verify and validate DG from Regional Apparatus.
- (3) Data Forum as intended in paragraph (1), determined by Regent's Decree.

### CHAPTER XI

#### COOPERATION

#### Article 27

- (1) The Regional Government develops a pattern of cooperation in order to realize the Regional DG in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.
- (2) Cooperation as intended in paragraph (1) is carried out by:
  - a. Government;
  - b. Regency/City Government;
  - c. College;
  - d. research institutions; And
  - e. the other party.

CHAPTER XII

THE ROLE OF SOCIETY AND THE BUSINESS WORLD

Article 28

- (1) The community, universities and the business world play a role in managing Regional DG.
- (2) The role of the community, universities and the business world as intended in paragraph (1) can be carried out through providing development DG, proposals for consideration and suggestions to the Regional Government in managing Regional DG.

CHAPTER XIII

CLOSING

Article 29

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
