IMPLEMENTATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITS THROUGH SERVICES
ELECTRONICALLY INTEGRATED BUSINESS LICENSING

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY
REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering:

a. that with the stipulation of Regulation of the Minister of Environment and Forestry Number 22 of 2018 concerning Norms, Standards, Procedures and Criteria for Electronically Integrated Licensing Services Scope of the Ministry of Environment and Forestry

Forestry needs to regulate the Implementation of Environmental Permits through Electronically Integrated Business Licensing Services;

b. that an Environmental Permit is granted to every person who carries out business and/or activities that require Amdal or UKL-UPL in the context of environmental protection and management;

c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning the Implementation of Environmental Permits Through Electronically Integrated Business Licensing Services;

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. One Stop Investment and Integrated Services Service, hereinafter referred to as the PM and PTSP Service is the Sukoharjo Regency One Stop Investment and Integrated Services Service.
5. The Head of the PM and PTSP Service is the Head of the PM and PTSP Service of Sukoharjo Regency.
6. The Environmental Service, hereinafter referred to as the LH Service, is the Sukoharjo Regency Environmental Service.
7. Electronically Integrated Business Licensing or the next *Online Single Submission* abbreviated as OSS is Business Licensing issued by the OSS Institution for and on behalf of ministers, heads of institutions, governors, or regent/mayor to Business Actors through the system integrated electronics.
8. OSS Management and Organizing Institutions, hereinafter referred to as OSS Institutions, are non-ministerial government institutions carrying out government affairs in the field of investment coordination. Which
9. Environmental Permit is a permit given to every person who carries out business and/or activities that require Amdal or UKL-UPL in the context of environmental protection and management as a prerequisite for obtaining a business and/or activity permit.
10. Analysis of environmental impacts, hereinafter referred to as Amdal, is a study of

the significant impact of a planned business and/or activity on the environment which is necessary for the decision-making process regarding the implementation of the business and/or activity.

11. The initiator is any person or government agency responsible for a business and/or activity to be implemented.
12. Business and/or activity is any form of activity that can cause changes to the environment and cause an impact on the environment;
13. Amdal Assessment Commission, hereinafter abbreviated as KPA, is the commission tasked with assessing Amdal documents.
14. Environmental management efforts and environmental monitoring efforts, hereinafter abbreviated as UKL-UPL, are the management and monitoring of businesses and/or activities that do not have a significant impact on the environment which is necessary for the decision-making process regarding the implementation of businesses and/or activities.
15. Environmental Impact Analysis, hereinafter referred to as Andal, is a careful and in-depth study of the significant impacts of a business plan and/or activity.
16. Environmental Management Plan, hereinafter referred to as RKL, is an effort to handle impacts on the environment resulting from business plans and/or activities.
17. Environmental Monitoring Plan, hereinafter referred to as RPL, is an effort to monitor environmental components that are impacted by business plans and/or activities.
18. Environmental feasibility decisions are decisions that state the environmental feasibility of a business plan and/or activity which must be accompanied by an Amdal.
19. UKL-UPL recommendation is a letter of approval for a business and/or activity that requires UKL-UPL.
20. Business and/or activity permits are permits issued by technical agencies to carry out business and/or activities.

ENVIRONMENTAL PERMISSION

Part One

General

Section 2

- (1) Environmental Permits are granted to business actors and/or activities that require Amdal or UKL-UPL in the context of protection and management environment as a prerequisite for obtaining a Business and/or Activity Permit.
- (2) Before applying for an Environmental Permit as intended in paragraph (1), business actors are required to have a Business Identification Number (NIB) issued by the OSS Institution.

The second part

Procedures for Application for Environmental Permits

And Fulfillment of Commitments

Article 3

- (1) Business actors submit applications permission
environment as intended in Article 2 paragraph (1) is carried out through the *Online Single Submission* (OSS) System.
- (2) Business actors are required to fulfill Environmental Permit commitments that have been issued by the OSS Institution.
- (3) Fulfillment of commitments as referred to in paragraph (2) is in accordance with statutory provisions.

Part Three

Submission of Notifications to the OSS System

Article 4

- (1) PM and PTSP Services provide Environmental Permit Notification.
- (2) Based on checking recommendations from the LH Service, the PM and PTSP Services provide notification via the OSS application.
- (3) Recommendations provided by the Department of Environment as intended in paragraph (2) if the Environmental Service approves the Environmental Permit, the PM and PTSP Services provide a Notification of approval.
- (4) The recommendation as intended in paragraph (3) is that the Environmental Service does not provide approval

for an Environmental Permit that has been issued by the OSS Institution, the PM and PTSP Department can refuse approval through the OSS application.

CHAPTER III

CLOSING

Article 5

When this Regent's Regulation comes into force:

- a. Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 42 of 2012 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Granting Environmental Permits in Sukoharjo Regency (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2012 Number 297); And
- b. Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 33 of 2014 concerning Delegation of Authority to Issue Environmental Permits for Businesses and/or Activities that are Required to Have UKL-UPL to the Head of the Environmental Agency (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette 2014 Number 260)

revoked and declared invalid.

Article 6

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date invited.

So that everyone is aware, this Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
