SECOND AMENDMENT TO REGENT REGULATION NUMBER 61 OF 2020
CONCERNING SERVICE CLOTHING FOR THE STATE CIVIL APPARATUS IN THE ENVIRONMENT
SUKOHARJO REGENCY GOVERNMENT

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY,

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that in order to support the Healthy Living Community Movement, it is necessary to adjust the official accreditation clothing for State Civil Service Employees at the Sukoharjo Regency Regional General Hospital;

b. that based on the considerations as intended in letter a, Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 61 of 2020 concerning Official Clothing for State Civil Apparatus within the Sukoharjo Regency Government

as amended by Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 23 of 2021 concerning Amendments to Regent Regulation Number 61 of 2020 concerning Official Clothing for State Civil Servants within the Sukoharjo Regency Government, needs to be amended;

c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning the Second Amendment to Regent's Regulation Number 61 of 2020 concerning Official Clothing for State Civil Servants within the Sukoharjo Regency Government;

DECIDE:

To stipulate: REGENT'S REGULATION CONCERNING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO REGENT'S REGULATION NUMBER 61 OF 2020 CONCERNING OFFICIAL CLOTHING FOR THE STATE CIVIL APPARATUS IN THE SUKOHARJO DISTRICT GOVERNMENT ENVIRONMENT.

Article I

Several provisions in the Sukoharjo Regent's Regulations Number 61 of 2020 concerning Civil Apparatus Service Clothing Country within the Sukoharjo Regency Government (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette 2020 Number 61) as amended by the Regent's Regulation Sukoharjo Number 23 of 2021 concerning Top Amendments Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 61 of 2020 concerning State Civil Apparatus Service Clothing in the Environment Sukoharjo Regency Government (Regency Regional News Sukoharjo Year 2021 Number 24), amended as follows:

1. The provisions of Article 15 are amended to read as follows following:

Article 15

a. PDU for Male Subdistrict Head and Male Village Head:

1. white shirt, plain black tie and white jacket with gold yellow buttons;
2. white trousers; And
3. Black leather socks and loafers laced.

b. PDU for Women Subdistrict Heads and Women Village Heads:

1. white shirt, plain black tie and white jacket with yellow buttons;
2. white skirt 15 cm below the knee; And
3. black loafers.

c. The PDU of the female sub-district head and the female sub-district head who wear the hijab and are pregnant adjust.

2. The provisions of Article 27 are amended to read as follows following:

Article 27

The use of official clothing for employees who have certain duties as intended in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter k is as follows:

a. Department of Transportation

1. PDH:

Monday to Sunday

a) Male PDH:

Plain white short-sleeved shirt with complete attributes, shoulder tongue, straight neck collar, front equipped with 2 (two) pockets with buttoned tongue, right and left shoulders equipped with shoulder tongue. *Dark blue* trousers are equipped with 2 (two) side pockets and 2 (two) back pockets.

b) Women's PDH:

Plain white short/long sleeve shirt with complete attributes, shoulder tongue, straight neck collar, skirt 10 cm below the knee/dark blue trousers, you can also wear a dark *blue* vest .).

c) For female employees who are pregnant or who wear appropriate Muslim clothing.

2. PDL:

When carrying out operational duties in the form of control, enforcement, inspection, supervision, implementation of land transportation functions and community services.

a) Men's and Women's PDLs consist of a light gray long-sleeved shirt with a shoulder tongue, stand-up neck, 2 (two) top right and left pockets covered with buttons, equipped with 2 (two) pockets with a buttoned tongue, right and left shoulders equipped with with shoulder straps, dark blue trousers without bottom pleats with 2 (two) side pockets and 2 (two) back pockets with a rear belt with complete attributes.

In the case of carrying out field duties other than law enforcement activities, the wearing of long-sleeved shirts is excluded.

- b) The PDL of Male and Female PPNS Officers consists of black short-sleeved shirt with shoulder tongue, stand-up neck, 2 (two) top pockets on the right and left covered by buttons.
- c) For women who wear the hijab, a headscarf with a color matching the color of the pants and wearing the headscarf shows the attributes of name and rank.

3. PDU:

During ceremonial activities within the Ministry of Transportation

a) Men's

PDU: Long-sleeved suit shirt with a turn-down collar in dark blue with a white shirt, long dark blue tie at the front equipped with 4 (four) closed pockets and metal buttons, the emblem of the Ministry of Transportation, gold yellow, trousers long dark blue with 2 (two) front side pockets and 2 (two) back pockets, black belt/buckle with the Ministry of Transportation emblem.

b) Women's

PDU: Long-sleeved suit shirt with a turn-down collar in dark blue with a white shirt, long dark blue tie, on the front equipped with 4 (four) closed pockets and metal buttons with the symbol of the Ministry of Transportation in yellow gold, dark blue skirt with a maximum size of 10 (ten) cm below the knee equipped with 2 (two) front side pockets/dark blue trousers with 2 (two) front side pockets and no back pockets.

4. Service Clothing for Periodic Vehicle Testers

Motorized;

When carrying out motor vehicle testing duties;

Dark blue/navy short-sleeved shirt with shoulder tongues, straight neck collar, dark blue/navy waram trousers, helmet/hat, helmet. The shirt and trousers are made of blue jean material.

b. public health Office

1. Doctors

Monday to Saturday:

PDH is for the public and wears a white doctor's coat.

2. Nurses and Midwives:

a) Monday and Tuesday:

Men: plain white short-sleeved shirt, khaki trousers.

Women: plain white short/long sleeve shirt, khaki skirt.

b) Wednesday to Saturday: Men:

plain white short-sleeved shirt, dark trousers.

Women: plain white short/long sleeve shirt, dark skirt.

3. Laboratory Personnel:

Monday to Saturday:

PDH is for the general public and wears a white long-sleeved button-back laboratory coat with elastic at the wrists.

c. One Investment and Integrated Services Service Door

1. Monday : PDH men light brown long-sleeved shirt, black tie, dark brown trousers; And

Brown PDH woman.

2. Tuesday : PDH men red long-sleeved shirt, black tie, black trousers; And

PDH woman in red

3. Wednesday : PDH men's turquoise green long-sleeved shirt, black tie, black trousers; And

Women wear blazers with a low collar and short-sleeved batik shirts as underwear

4. Thursday: PDH batik/woven/lurik and/or regional traditional clothing with black skirts/trousers.

5. Friday of week 1, and week 2:

Sportswear is worn from 07.00 WIB to 09.00 WIB followed by PDH Batik Sukoharjo Makmur 1 with black trousers for men/skirts for women (not jeans).

6. Friday of the 3rd week, 4th week and in the 3rd week
5:

Sportswear is worn from 07.00 WIB to 09.00
WIB followed by PDH Batik Sukoharjo Makmur
2 with black skirts/trousers (not jeans).

d. Regional public hospital

1. PDH Medical Staff:

- a) Monday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom;
- b) Tuesday: top accreditation clothes, bottom brown cream;
- c) Wednesday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom;
- d) Thursday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom;
- e) Friday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom;
- f) Saturday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom;
- And
- g) Sunday: white doctor's coat on top, black/dark bottom.

2. PDH Nurses and Midwives:

- a) Monday: cream top, khaki bottom;
- b) Tuesday: top accreditation clothes, bottom brown cream;
- c) Wednesday: white top, white bottom;
- d) Thursday: maroon top, black bottom;
- e) Friday: blue top, blue bottom;
- f) Saturday: light gray top, dark gray bottom; And
- g) Sunday: top is light green, bottom is dark green.

3. PDH Other Health Workers (Nakes):

- a) Monday: light brown top, brown bottom;
- b) Tuesday: top accreditation clothes, bottom brown cream;
- c) Wednesday: light blue top, dark blue bottom;
- d) Thursday: light green top, dark green bottom;
- e) Friday: top cream, bottom gray;
- f) Saturday: top dark gray, bottom light gray; And
- g) Sunday: batik top, black bottom.

4. PDH for Structural Officials, General Administration

and Service Administration:

- a) Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday: PDH for public; And
- b) Tuesday: top accreditation clothing, bottom brown beige.

e. Civil Service Police Unit and Fire Department

1. Civil Service Police Unit

Monday to Sunday

a) PDH:

- 1) PDH is used to carry out daily tasks.

2) Male PDH:

Dark greenish khaki short-sleeved shirt, stand-up collar, 5 (five) buttons in the middle of the shirt, shoulder straps with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest equipped with buttons. cover, dark greenish khaki colored trousers, 2 (two) open trouser side pockets, 2 (two) closed back pockets equipped with pocket closure buttons, trousers without ruffles/folds, black belt with the Praja Wibawa logo in gold yellow , black PDH socks and shoes.

3) Women's PDH:

Short-sleeved and/or long-sleeved shirt in dark greenish khaki color, shoulder tongue with 1 (one) button each, stand-up collar, 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest equipped with closing buttons , short/long skirt and/or dark greenish khaki trousers, 2 (two) open slanted side pockets of the skirt/pants, trousers without ties/ties, black belt with the Praja Wibawa logo in gold yellow, socks and black PDH shoes.

For those who wear the hijab and pregnant women, adjust.

b) PDL:

- 1) PDL I is used when carrying out coaching, socialization, monitoring and supervision tasks for Pol PP and the community.
- 2) PDL II is used by members of the Civil Service Police when carrying out the duties of enforcing regional regulations and local regulations) as well as maintaining public order and public peace.

3) PDL I

Long-sleeved shirt in dark greenish khaki color, turned-down collar, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt, 2 (two) closed patch pockets on the chest with pocket closure buttons, shirt sleeves equipped with cuffs, trousers long dark greenish khaki color without creases, dark greenish khaki colored beret with 2 (two) closed trouser side patch pockets equipped with pocket closure buttons, cream colored rim coupling with Satpol PP emblem and acetal belt head, t-shirt Dark greenish khaki oblong with the Praja Wibawa emblem, black leather socks and boots. Used when carrying out coaching, outreach, monitoring and supervision duties for Civil Service Police officers and the community.

4) PDL II

Dark greenish khaki long-sleeved shirt with cuffs, shoulder straps with 1 (one) button each, reclined shirt collar, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt, 2 (two) closed patch pockets on the chest. pieces equipped with pocket closure buttons, dark greenish khaki colored trousers without sash/folds, 2 (two) slanted trouser pockets and 2 (two) closed trouser side patch pockets equipped with pocket closure buttons, rear trouser patch pockets Closed in 2 (two) pieces with pocket closure buttons, rim and blood rim coupling with Satpol PP emblem made of nylon and belt head made of acetal, dark greenish khaki T-shirt with Praja Wibawa emblem, light brown socks and field shoes .

5) PDL I and II for women wearing the hijab, the hijab is tucked into the shirt collar, berets and *field* caps are worn over the hijab.

c) PDUs:

1) PDU I is used by police structural officials

Civil Service while attending state ceremonies and the funeral of Pol PP .

2) PDU II is used by Civil Service Police structural officials when attending regional government birthday ceremonies, Satpol PP birthdays, TNI/Polri birthdays, inaugurations and inaugurations.

3) PDU I Male:

Long-sleeved shirt, dark greenish khaki, has 1 (one) button on each shoulder, jacket style shirt collar, 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, has 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest. equipped with pocket closure buttons, also has 2 (two) closed pockets on the waist which are equipped with pocket closure buttons, all the shirt buttons are large buttons with the Civil Service Police logo made of brass, wear a white shirt with long sleeves and a tie black, dark greenish khaki trousers without creases, 2 (two) side pockets, 2 (two) closed back pockets equipped with pocket closure buttons, socks and black leather shoes/PDU shoes, with laces or without straps.

4) PDU I Women:

Long-sleeved shirt, dark greenish khaki, has 1 (one) button on each shoulder, jacket style shirt collar, 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, has 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest. equipped with pocket closure buttons, also has 2 (two) closed pockets on the waist which are equipped with pocket closure buttons, all the shirt buttons are large buttons with the Civil Service Police logo made of brass, wear a white shirt with long sleeves and a tie black, dark greenish khaki trousers without creases, 2 (two) side pockets, 2 (two) closed back pockets equipped with pocket closure buttons, socks and black leather shoes/PDU shoes, with laces or without straps.

For those who wear the hijab, the color of the hijab is dark greenish khaki.

5) PDU II Men:

Short-sleeved shirt, dark greenish khaki, has 1 (one) button on each shoulder, stand-up collar, 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, has 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest equipped with pocket closure buttons, also has 2 (two) closed pockets on the waist equipped with pocket closure buttons, has 2 (two) closed pockets

on the chest which is equipped with a pocket closure button, also has 2 (two) closed pockets on the waist which is equipped with a pocket closure button, wears an outer waistband with the Praja Wibawa emblem and a dark greenish khaki colored T-shirt, colored trousers dark greenish khaki with 2 (two) open side pockets and 2 (two) closed back pockets, belt head with the Civil Service Police logo, socks and black leather shoes/ office shoes, with laces or without laces.

6) PDU II Women:

Short and long sleeved shirts (for those who wear the hijab) dark greenish khaki color, shoulder straps each with 1 (one) button, sleep style shirt collar, 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, have 2 (two) a closed pocket on the chest which is equipped with a pocket closure button, also has 2 (two) closed pockets on the waist which is equipped with a pocket closure button, has 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest which is equipped with a pocket closure button, short skirt below the knee and long skirt (for those who wear the headscarf) greenish khaki color without pockets, wearing a shirt belt with the Praja Wibawa emblem in gold yellow, socks and black leather shoes/office shoes.

d) Official Clothing for Internal Action Officers (PDPTI)

1) PDPTI is used by Satpol PP internal action officers when carrying out internal supervision duties and enforcing the Pol PP code of ethics.

2) Dark greenish khaki long-sleeved shirt, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt, 1 (one) button on the shoulders, 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest, reclined shirt collar, no cuffs, white T-shirt, dark greenish khaki trousers without creases/creases, dark greenish khaki colored beret, white rim clasp, white T-shirt, slanted side trouser pockets and patch pocket on the back of the trousers, Praja emblem coupling with the

Authority and white suspenders/sem pang, yellow armband that says Task Force
Trantibum (black with black)

used to carry out transit in the field, black socks, black leather boots/field shoes (PDPTI) with white outer sides.

e) Official Clothing for Pataka Officers (PDPP)

- 1) PDPP is used by members of the Civil Service Police carrying the standard during ceremonies, inauguration/ handover of the position of Kasatpol.
- 2) Dark greenish khaki long-sleeved shirt, shoulder straps with 1 (one) button each, stand-up collar, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt, 2 (two) closed pockets on the chest with buttons covering the pockets, dark greenish khaki T-shirt with the Pol PP logo on the left chest, dark greenish khaki trousers with no seams/ folds, 2 (two) open slanted side pockets of trousers, 2 back pockets of trousers (two) pieces, rubberized at the bottom of the trousers, white helmet with the Praja emblem

Authority, rim clutch, khaki T-shirt
old greenish, black socks, PDPP shoes.

f) Music Corps Official Clothing (PDKM)

- 1) PDKM is only used by Corps Officers
Civil Service Police Music.
- 2) Dark greenish khaki long-sleeved shirt with cuffs using a shoulder tongue with one button and sleeper collar, plain front slit shirt with 9 (nine) slanted buttons and a white cloth sash 15 cm wide from the left shoulder to the right waist together with the shirt , t-shirt in dark greenish khaki with the Praja Wibawa logo on the left chest, white trousers with 3 (three) large lus, side pockets with a slant style, yellow chord for the team leader and blue for the members, wearing a whistle on the shoulder right, blue armband with the Ministry of Home Affairs logo on the right and armband with the regional logo on the left with the words Corps of Music.

g) Special Task Force Service Clothes

1) Special Task Force official clothing is used for mentoring, counseling, socialization and monitoring and evaluation activities for Pol PP.

2) Form and model of special Task Force official clothing as listed in Appendix VI.

2. Firefighters

Monday to Sunday

a) PDH:

1) PDH is used from Monday to Sunday or to carry out daily tasks.

2) Men's PDH

Blue short-sleeved shirt, stand-up collar, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt in the same color as the shirt, tongues on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each and 2 (two) closed top pockets with 1 (one) button each, stitching line on the back shoulder running from right to left, monogram at the ends of both shoulder collars, rank marks according to position and class, province or district/city written on the left sleeve, regional government badge under the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, fire extinguisher badge below the fire extinguisher, position mark on the right pocket, name plate above the right breast pocket, assignment mark placed above the left breast pocket, award badge/award brevet placed on top of the nameplate, Korpri badge placed above the firefighter badge, firefighter badge installed on the left pocket above the service ribbon, identification badge in the left pocket, black belt with buckle gold with a fire extinguisher logo, *navy blue* trousers with side pockets on each side and 2 (two) back pockets.

3) Female PDH

Short/long sleeve shirt for those wearing a blue headscarf, sleeping collar with 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt in the same color as the shirt, tongue on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets and 2 (two) closed bottom pockets with 1 (one) button each, stitching line on back shoulder running from right to left edge, inside pocket

on the bottom of the shirt on the right and left with the pocket tongue out, monogram at the ends of both shoulder collars, rank marks according to position and class, province or district/city writing on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the province or district/city writing, firefighter inscription on the right sleeve, firefighter badge below the firefighter inscription, position badge in the right pocket, name plate above the right shirt pocket, assignment badge placed above the left shirt pocket, award/award brevet displayed on top nameplate, Korpri badge placed above the firefighter badge, firefighter badge installed above the left pocket above the service ribbon, identification badge in the left pocket, span skirt below the knee without ruffles/long skirt/navy blue trousers , if you wear trousers with 2 (two) side pockets on each side.

b) PDL:

- 1) PDL is used by both men and women carrying out field tasks.
- 2) Long sleeve sleep collar shirt with 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt in the same color as the shirt, tongue on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each and 2 (two) closed top pockets with 1 button each (one) piece, monogram embroidered on the left collar with a yellow helmet and ax logo on a blue base, embroidered rank marks according to position and class on the right collar with a blue base, province or district/city writing on the other sleeve left, regional government badge under the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, firefighter badge below the fire extinguisher, embroidered position badge on the right pocket, name plate above the right shirt pocket according to echeloning, embroidered name plate above the right shirt pocket with yellow writing, yellow list and blue base color, assignment mark placed above the left shirt pocket, embroidered award/award brevet placed above the name plate, embroidered Korpri badge placed above the colored firefighter badge yellow, embroidered firefighter badge installed above the left pocket yellow, embroidered writing

extinguisher on top of left shirt pocket with yellow writing, yellow list and blue base color, black belt and black clutch with plastic clutch head, navy blue trousers with side pockets on each side, 2 (two) back pockets and 2 (two) hanging pockets on each side of the middle of the trousers.

c) PDU I

- 1) PDU I is used by structural firefighters/OPD officials in charge of firefighters when attending national ceremonies, state ceremonies, Day Ceremonies

Proclamation of Indonesian Independence, Day Ceremony Heroes, firefighter birthday ceremonies every March 1, inauguration ceremonies and other ceremonies according to superiors' instructions, foreign service, receptions with foreign guests

2) PDU I Men

Blue long-sleeved jacket with sleep collar
 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongued on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets closed with 1 (one) button each and 2 (two) pockets each bottom covered with 1 (one) button each, yellow gold metal shirt buttons with a firefighter emblem, white shirt inside jacket, long plain navy blue tie, rank insignia according to position and class, provincial or *district* writing / city on the left sleeve, regional government badge under the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, firefighter badge under the fire extinguisher, position badge in the right pocket, name plate above the shirt pocket on the right, the assignment mark is placed above the left breast pocket, the award mark/ brevet of award is placed above the nameplate, the Korpri badge is placed above the firefighter badge, the firefighter badge is installed above the left pocket, the Satya Medal, the Satya Karya Badge service badge is installed between the firefighter badge and the top left pocket, navy blue trousers , with side pockets on each side and 2 (two) back pockets.

3) PDU I Women

Blue long-sleeved jacket with sleep collar
 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongued on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets closed with 1 (one) button each and 2 (two) bottom pockets covered with 1 (one) button each, yellow gold metal shirt buttons with the firefighter emblem, white shirt inside the jacket, wearing a dark blue bow tie, rank insignia according to position and class, provincial or district/city on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, firefighter badge below the fire extinguisher, position badge in the right pocket, name plate above the pocket right shirt, assignment badge placed above the left pocket, award badge/brevet of award placed above the nameplate, Korpri badge placed above the firefighter badge, firefighter badge installed above the left pocket, service badge Satya Medal, Satya Karya Lencana installed between the firefighter badge and the top left pocket, using inside pockets on the bottom of the shirt on each side with the pocket tongue out, *navy blue* trousers , using side pockets on each side and 2 (two) back pockets.

d) PDU II

- 1) PDU II is used by structural firefighters/OPD officials in charge of firefighters when attending inauguration ceremonies, inauguration of birthdays for the firefighters and other regional/agency apparatus as well as funeral ceremonies for fallen/died firefighters.

2) PDU II Men

Blue short-sleeved shirt, stand-up collar, 6 (six) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongue on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets and 2 (two) bottom pockets covered with 1 (one) button each, yellow gold metal shirt buttons with firefighter symbols, monograms at the ends of both shirt collars, rank marks according to position and

class, province or district/city writing on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the province or district/city writing, fire extinguisher writing on the right sleeve, firefighter badge below the fire extinguisher writing, position badge on the right pocket, nameplate above the shirt pocket

on the right, the assignment mark is placed above the left breast pocket, the award mark/brevet of award is placed above the nameplate, the Korpri badge is placed above the firefighter badge, the firefighter badge is installed above the left pocket, the service badge is the Satya Medal, Lencana Karya Satya installed between the firefighter badge and the top left pocket, a royal blue cloth belt with color code 392 in the same color as the shirt, 3 (three) belt lus located on the left and right sides and the back, navy blue trousers, wearing side pockets on each side and 2 (two) back pockets.

3) PDU II Women

Short sleeve/long sleeve shirt for those wearing a blue headscarf, sleep collar, 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongue on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets and 2 (two) closed bottom pockets with 1 (one) button each, yellow gold metal shirt buttons with a firefighter symbol, monogram at the end of both sleeper collars, rank marks according to position and class, provincial or district/city writing on the left sleeve, regional government badge under the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, firefighter badge under the fire fighter, position badge in the right pocket, name plate above the right shirt pocket, the assignment mark is placed above the left breast pocket, the award mark/brevet of award is placed above the name plate, the Korpri badge is placed above the firefighter badge, the firefighter badge is installed above the left pocket, the Satya Medal ribbon service mark

Karya Satya badge installed between the firefighter badge and the top left pocket, royal blue cloth belt with color code 392 in the same color as the shirt, lus

3 (three) belts located on the left and right sides and the back, *navy blue* span skirt/trousers/long skirt with color code 383 without gluing, especially for trousers with side pockets.

e) Service Clothes for Bearing the Banner of Honor

1) Official Clothes for Bearing the Banner of Honor are worn by Firefighters Carrying the Banner/Flag of Honor/ Pataka when carrying out their duties at the firefighter's birthday ceremony every March 1 and the birthdays of regional officials.

2) Blue long-sleeved jacket with sleep collar

4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongued on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets closed with 1 (one) button each and 2 (two) bottom pockets covered with 1 (one) button each, red slayer cloth used from neck to chest inside the shirt, white gloves, rank marks according to position and class, province or district/city written on the left sleeve, government badge area under the words province or district/city, fire extinguisher written on the right sleeve, firefighter badge under the fire extinguisher, position mark on the right pocket, name plate above the right hand shirt pocket, assignment mark placed on the next shirt pocket left, award badge/brevet of award mounted on top of nameplate, Korpri badge mounted on top of firefighter badge, firefighter badge mounted on top of left pocket, medal service badge mounted between firefighter badge and top left pocket, blue *trousers navy* using a red side list with side pockets on each side and 2 (two) pockets on the back, a white coat, a yellow head cap with a firefighter symbol, a white draghrim crossed on the front, specifically for standard flag bearers equipped with a flagpole holder .

f) Music Corps Ceremonial Service Clothing

- 1) Music Corps Ceremonial Official Clothing is worn by music corps officers when carrying out ceremonial duties.
- 2) Blue long-sleeved jacket, sleep collar with 4 (four) buttons in the middle of the shirt, tongue on each shoulder with 1 (one) button each, 2 (two) top pockets closed with 1 (one) button each) fruit and 2 (two) closed bottom pockets with 1 (one) button each, on each wrist there are 2 (two) yellow circular lines, yellow gold metal shirt buttons with a firefighter symbol, light blue shirt on the inside of the jacket, long plain red tie, rank marks according to position and class, province or district/city writing on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the province or district/city writing, fire extinguisher writing on on the right sleeve, firefighter badge under the words firefighter, position badge on the right pocket, nameplate above the right shirt pocket, assignment badge placed above the top left pocket, award/award brevet placed above the nameplate, badge The Korpri is placed above the firefighter's badge, the firefighter's badge is placed above the left pocket, the service medal is placed between the firefighter's badge and the top left pocket, the yellow shoulder strap/curl is placed on the right shoulder circle, the trousers are navy *blue* , using side pockets on each side and 2 (two) back pockets.

g) Rescue clothing for non-fire operations

- 1) Rescue clothing for non-fire operations is used by firefighters when carrying out rescue operations for non-fire operations.
- 2) The basic red overalls/suit model with color code 178 3434 with a combination of blue and stripes and bright silver stripes, rank marks according to position and class on the right collar of the shirt are embroidered in blue, blue extinguisher border writing with a red base is placed above the left pocket, a blue name border with a red base is placed above the right pocket, zipper

in double, the words province or district/city on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the words province or district/city, firefighter logo on the right sleeve,

using hanging pockets on each side of the trousers and the back of the trousers, using pads on the elbows and knees on the inside, each cuff of the sleeves and bottom of the trousers using adhesive, there is the writing "FIRE FIGHTERS AND RESCUERS" on the back using a bright silver color, wearing this shirt equipped with a rescue helmet, rescue gloves, boots and other personal safety equipment.

h) Heat Resistant Clothing

- 1) Heat Resistant Clothing is used by firefighters when carrying out extinguishing and rescue operations during a fire.
- 2) Khaki colored heat resistant jacket and trousers use outer, middle and inner layered fabric composition, the number of pockets is adjusted to the needs and function, the clothing list uses gold and silver colors which can emit light in low lighting conditions and has the words "FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND SAVIOR" on the back which uses a bright silver color. Wearing this clothing is equipped with personal safety equipment such as Fire Helmet, Fire Gloves, Fire Boots, Fire Google and other personal safety equipment.
- 3) Structural officials who take part in operations use specially marked fire helmets.

i) Fire Resistant Clothing

- 1) Fireproof clothing is used by firefighters when carrying out fire extinguishing and rescue operations under certain conditions as needed.
- 2) Model and type of flame retardant clothing using fabric/clothing material compositions that comply with internationally applicable safety and security standards.

j) Fire handling clothing, hazardous materials and poisonous

- 1) Fire handling clothing, hazardous and toxic materials, used by firefighters when carrying out extinguishing and rescue operations during a fire with hazardous and toxic materials according to their level.
- 2) Model and type of clothing for handling fires, hazardous and toxic materials using fabric/clothing material compositions that comply with internationally applicable safety and security standards.

k) Alert Clothing

- 1) Alert Clothing, used by firefighters when carrying out alert duties and picket/guard duties at command posts.
- 2) Long sleeve t-shirt in basic gray color with a combination of stripes, the name is embroidered and placed on the right side of the chest using adhesive, uses an inside pocket with a zipper closure, uses black padding on both elbows, colored fire extinguisher writing on the back black, wearing a black belt with a metal buckle head with a firefighter logo, navy blue trousers with side pockets on each side, 2 (two) back pockets and 2 (two) hanging pockets on each side of the middle of the trousers, pocket hang 2 (two) pieces on each side of the back of the trousers using adhesive, hanging pockets on each side of the middle of the trousers

using adhesive, black long-soled/PDL shoes with laces, with the words "FIRE FIGHTERS AND RESCUERS" on the back.

l) Technical Clothing

- 1) Technical clothing, used by firefighters when carrying out engineering activities and fire equipment workshop tasks.
- 2) Blue technical clothing with a combination of stripes and overalls, the workshop qualification mark is placed above the embroidered left pocket, the fire extinguisher is placed on the right sleeve, the fire extinguisher logo is placed below the fire extinguisher, the name is placed above the right pocket embroidered, inside zipper, provincial writing or

district/city on the left sleeve, regional government badge below the words province or district/city, using a hanging pocket on each side of the trousers and trousers on the back, with the words "FIRE FIGHTERS AND RESCUERS" on the back.

f. Regional Disaster Management Agency

1. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday: PDH for
general

2. Tuesday:

a) Men's PDH: short-sleeved shirt, shoulder straps, light brown, dark green trousers.

b) PDH Women: short sleeve blouse, shoulder straps, light brown short/long skirt dark green.

c) The BNPB logo is used on official clothing, ID tags, hats, belts.

3. PDL is used when on duty in the field based on calendar days;

4. Field work t-shirts are worn when on duty in the field based on calendar days;
And

5. Vests are worn when on duty in the field based on calendar days.

6. Official clothing as referred to in Article 23 paragraph (1) is equipped with attributes related to official clothing.

3. Attachment V Official Clothing for Employees Who Have Specific Duties at Regional General Hospitals is amended, so that it is as stated in the Attachment which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

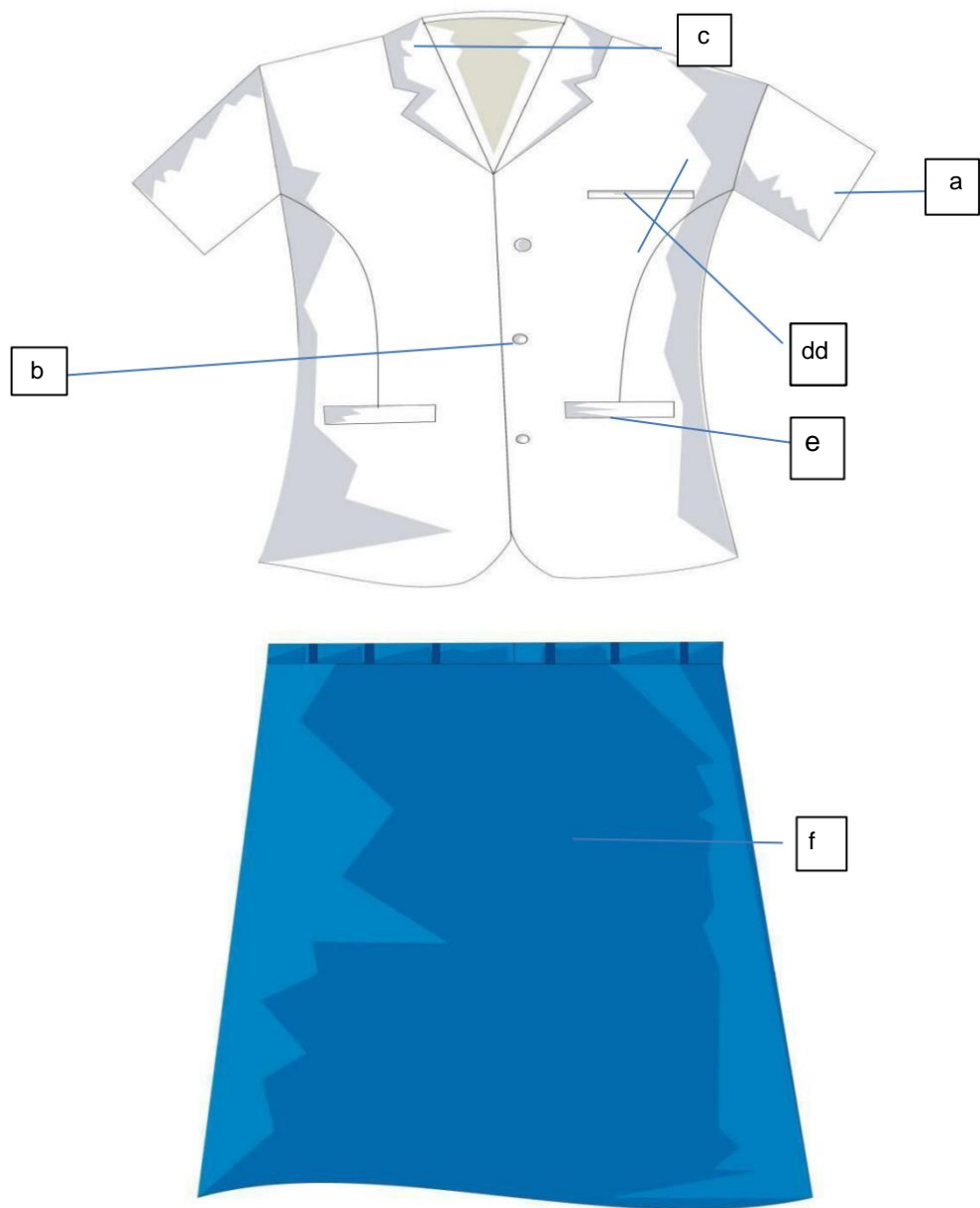
