PLANTING PATTERNS AND PLANNING IN IRRIGATION AREA
YEAR 2017-2018

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that in order to maintain the condition of the irrigation network, the level of soil fertility, break the cycle of pest populations and the rotation of plant varieties, it is necessary to determine planting patterns and planting plans in irrigation areas in Sukoharjo Regency;

b. that based on the considerations as intended in letter a, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning Planting Patterns and Planting Management Plans in Irrigation Areas for 2017-2018;

DECIDE :

To stipulate: REGENT'S REGULATION CONCERNING CROPTING PATTERNS AND PLANNING PLANNING IN IRRIGATION AREAS FOR 2017-2018.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional government is the Regent as the organizing element of the Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which fall under the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. Cropping pattern is a framework for utilizing agricultural land for agricultural cultivation purposes in a certain area and within a certain period of time.
5. Planting management is the planning and preparation of the use of irrigated rice fields by taking into account the plant management system in an irrigated area within a period of 1 (one) year for the purpose of agricultural business in the rainy and dry seasons.
6. Irrigation is the business of providing, regulating and disposing of irrigation water to support agriculture, the types of which include surface irrigation, swamp irrigation, underground water irrigation, pump irrigation and pond irrigation.
7. The class system is an arrangement for dividing irrigation areas into several groups of rice fields.
8. The Water User Farmers Association, hereinafter abbreviated to P3A, is an irrigation management institution which is a forum for water-using farmers in a service area/tertiary plot or village which is formed democratically by water-using farmers, including local irrigation management institutions.
9. The Association of Water User Farmers' Associations, hereinafter abbreviated as GP3A, is an institution of a number of P3As that have agreed to work together to utilize irrigation water and irrigation networks in secondary block service areas, a combination of several secondary blocks, or 1 (one) irrigation area.

CHAPTER II

PLANTING PATTERNS AND PLANNING PLANNING FOR 2017-2018

Section 2

(1) Irrigated rice fields are divided into 3 (three) planting periods throughout year with the following division:

a. Colo Irrigation Area:

1. beginning of November to end of February = Planting Season (MT) I;
2. mid-February to mid-month June = Planting Season (MT) II; And
3. beginning of June to end of October = Planting Season (MT) III.

b. Non Colo Irrigation Area:

1. beginning of November to end of February = Planting Season (MT) I;
2. beginning of March to end of June = Season Planting (MT) II; And
3. beginning of July to end of October = Planting Season (MT) III.

(2) Planting Arrangement Plan with Rice-Padi-Padi and Padi-Padi-Plawija Planting Patterns in irrigation areas in Sukoharjo Regency for the 2017-2018 Planting Season as intended in paragraph (1) is listed in Appendix I which is an inseparable part of the Regulation this Regent.

Article 3

Planting patterns must be determined appropriately to ensure sufficient water is available for plant needs.

Article 4

(1) The basis for water distribution planning is the need to ensure that the water available from the source can be distributed evenly to all tertiary plots in the irrigation network.

- (2) When the water source is insufficient to meet the plant's water needs by continuous irrigation, the plant is given water in turns.
- (3) The water rotation system will be regulated by the authorized service and submitted to P3A Dharma Tirta.
- (4) During the dry season water supply during Planting Period III, the water condition is critical, so the provision of plant water will be prioritized for planned plants and to avoid plant drought, farmers are allowed to install pantek wells.

Article 5

- (1) The planting plan is prepared and regulated for each year by considering the following factors:
 - a. records and plant needs in the past;
 - b. production of certain crop cultivation at a time present and future;
 - c. soil leakage, water availability and weather climate conditions; And
 - d. labor input on agricultural land and the role of the community.
- (2) The planting plan is prepared and arranged into 2 (two) part :
 - a. The Global Planting Management Plan (RTTG) is detailed per sub-district; And
 - b. Detailed Planting Plan (RTTD) detailed per 1 (one) irrigation area.

Article 6

Provisions for Planting Pattern and Arrangement Plans, Calculation of Water Needs for Colo Irrigation Areas, and non-Colo Irrigation Areas 2017-2018 as stated in Appendix II which is an inseparable part of this Regent's Regulation.

Article 7

(1) Drying of irrigation canals in the Colo Irrigation Area for 2018 is regulated and determined for 31 (thirty one) days.

(2) Drying of channels in Irrigation Areas outside the Colo Irrigation Area is regulated and determined according to the agreement of each GP3A/P3A.

CHAPTER III

CLOSING

Article 8

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this Regent's Regulation is ordered to be promulgated by placing it in the Regional Gazette of Sukoharjo Regency.
