PRIORITY USE VILLAGE FUND YEAR 2022

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

SUKOHARJO REGENT,

- Considering : a. that the priority of using Village Funds in the context of national economic recovery , implementation of national priority programs and mitigation and handling of natural and non-natural disasters according to the authority of the Village due to the *2019 Corona Virus Disease ( Covid -19 )* pandemic needs to be adjusted;
- b. that in setting priorities for the use of village funds need consider effort handling pandemic *Corona Virus Disease 2019 (Covid-19)* and its impact on village which directed for strengthen adaptation new habits and national economic recovery in accordance with authority village;
- c. that with the enactment of the Regulation of the Minister of Villages, Development of Disadvantaged Regions , and Transmigration Number 7 of 2021 concerning Priority for Use of Village Funds in 2022 , it is necessary to regulate in detail the priority of using Village Funds in Sukoharjo Regency;
- d. that based on the considerations as referred to in letters a, b and c, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent Regulation concerning the Priority of Use of Village Funds in 2022 2 ;

DECIDE:

To stipulate : REGULATION OF THE REGENCY CONCERNING PRIORITIES FOR THE USE OF VILLAGE FUNDS IN 2022.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent Regulation, what is meant by:

1. The area is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. Regional Government is the Regent as an element of regional government organizer who leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
4. Village is a legal community unit that has territorial boundaries that are authorized to regulate and manage government affairs, the interests of the local community based on community initiatives, origin rights and/or traditional rights that are recognized and respected in the government system of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.

5. Village Funds are funds sourced from the State Revenue and Expenditure Budget designated for Villages which are transferred through the Regency Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget and are used to fund government administration, development implementation, community development, and community empowerment.
6. Village Authority is the authority possessed by the Village including authority in the field of Village Administration, implementation of Village Development, Village Community Development and Village Community Empowerment based on community initiatives, origin rights and Village customs.
7. Authority based on the right of origin is a right that is a living inheritance and the initiative of the Village or the initiative of the Village community in accordance with the development of community life .
8. Village-scale local authority is the authority to regulate and manage the interests of the Village community that have been carried out by the Village or are able and effectively carried out by the Village or which arise due to the development of the Village and village community initiatives.
9. The Village Consultative Body, hereinafter abbreviated as BPD, is an institution that carries out government functions whose members are representatives of the Village population based on regional representation and are determined democratically.
10. The Village Deliberation is a deliberation between the Village Consultative Body, the Village Government, and elements of the community organized by the Village Consultative Body to agree on strategic matters.
11. The Village Government is the Village Head assisted by the Village apparatus as an element of the Village Government organizer.
12. Village Administration is the administration of government affairs and the interests of the local community in the government system of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.
13. Village development is an effort to improve the quality of life and life for the greatest welfare of the village community.
14. Village Community Empowerment is an effort to develop community independence and welfare by increasing knowledge, attitudes, skills, behavior, abilities, awareness, and utilizing resources through the establishment of policies, programs, activities, and assistance in accordance with the essence of the problem and priority needs of the Village community.

15. The Village Medium-Term Development Plan, hereinafter referred to as RPJM Desa, is a Village planning document for a period of 6 (six) years.
16. The Village Government Work Plan, hereinafter referred to as RKP Desa, is the elaboration of the Village RPJM for a period of 1 (one) year.
17. The Village Revenue and Expenditure Budget , hereinafter referred to as the Village APB, is the Village Government's annual financial plan.
18. Priority for the Use of Village Funds is a choice of activities that take precedence and take precedence over other activity options to be financed with Village Funds.
19. Padat Karya Tunai Desa, hereinafter abbreviated as PKTD, is an activity to empower rural communities, especially the poor and marginalized, which is productive by prioritizing the use of resources, labor, and local technology to provide additional wages/income, reduce poverty, and improve people's welfare.
20. *Corona Virus Disease 2019* hereinafter referred to as *Covid - 19* is an infectious disease caused by *Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome-Corona Virus-2*.
21. *Covid-19* pandemic is a disaster caused by non-natural factors, namely *Covid-19* which threatens and disrupts the lives and livelihoods of the Village community, resulting in human casualties and social, economic, health and psychological or human psychological impacts.
22. *Covid-19* Safe Village is a condition of Village life that remains productive in the midst of the *Covid-19 Pandemic* with the discipline of residents implementing health protocols by using masks, maintaining physical distance, and washing hands with soap and running water.
23. Direct Village Fund Cash Assistance, hereinafter referred to as Village Fund BLT, is an activity of providing direct assistance in the form of cash funds sourced from the Village Fund to beneficiary families with agreed criteria and decided through village meetings.
24. *Sustainable Development Goals* , hereinafter referred to as *SDGs Desa*, are an integrated effort to realize a village without poverty and hunger, an economic village that grows evenly, a village that cares about health, a village that cares about the environment, a village that cares about education, a village that is friendly to women, a networked village, and a culturally responsive village to accelerate the achievement of goals. sustainable development.

25. Professional Assistance Personnel are professional staff recruited by the Ministry that carries out government affairs in the field of Villages, development of disadvantaged areas, and transmigration in charge of mentoring at the Village, District, Regency and Provincial levels.
26. Ministry is the ministry that carries out government affairs in the field of village and rural development, empowerment of rural communities, acceleration of development of underdeveloped areas, and transmigration.

## Section 2

The scope of the regulation of this Regent Regulation includes:

- a. Prioritas Use Village Fund Year 2022 ; and
- b. General guidelines for implementing the use of the 2022 Village Fund.

## Article 3

- (1) The priority setting for the use of Village Funds as referred to in Article 2 letter a aims to provide a reference:
  - a. The Regional Government and Village Government in implementing the national policy of state financial stabilization in the context of facing threats that endanger the national economic system and/or financial system stability ;
  - b. Regional Government in monitoring, evaluating, assisting village communities, fostering and facilitating priority use of Village Funds;
  - c. Regional Government and Village Government in facilitating the implementation of Village Authority based on Origin Rights and Village-Scale Local Authorities as well as monitoring and evaluating the status of Village development; and
  - d. The Village Government in setting priorities for the use of Village Funds in Village planning and development activities .
- (2) Priority p usage Fund The village as referred to in paragraph (1) is compiled based on the principle:
  - a. humanity;
  - b. justice;
  - c. diversity;
  - d. the balance of nature; and
  - e. National strategic policy based on village authority .
- (3) Priority Setting p usage Fund The village as referred to in paragraph (1) consists of :
  - a. priority of using Village Funds;

- b. setting priorities for the use of Village Funds;
- c. publication and reporting; and
- d. construction.

Article 4

- (1) The general guidelines for implementing the priority use of the Village Fund as referred to in Article 2 letter b are intended to provide direction in implementing the priority use of the Village Fund 2022 .
- (2) The general guidelines for the implementation of the use of the Year 2022 Village Fund as referred to in paragraph (1) are listed in the Appendix which is an integral part of this Regent's Regulation.

CHAPTER I I  
PRIORITIES FOR USE OF VILLAGE FUNDS

Article 5

- (1) The priority of using the Village Fund as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (3) letter a is regulated and managed by the Village based on the authority of the Village.
- (2) The priority of using the Village Fund as referred to in paragraph (1) is directed to programs and/or activities to accelerate the achievement of the Village *SDGs* through:
  - a. national economic recovery in accordance with the authority of the Village;
  - b. national priority programs in accordance with the authority of the Village; and
  - c. mitigation and handling of natural and non-natural disasters in accordance with the authority of the Village .

Article 6

- (1) The use of Village Funds for national economic recovery in accordance with the authority of the Village as referred to in Article 5 paragraph (2) letter a is prioritized for the achievement of Village *SDGs* through:
  - a. poverty alleviation, to realize a village without poverty;
  - b. establishment, development and capacity building for managing Village-owned enterprises/Village-owned enterprises together for equitable Village economic growth; and
  - c. development and development of productive economic businesses, which are prioritized to be managed by Village-owned enterprises/Village-owned enterprises together to realize environmentally conscious Village consumption and production.

- (2) The use of the Village Fund for national priority programs in accordance with the Village authority as referred to in Article 5 paragraph (2) letter b is prioritized for achieving the Village *SDGs* through:
  - a. Village data collection, mapping of potential and resources, and management of information and communication technology as an effort to expand partnerships for Village development;
  - b. development of tourist Villages for equitable Village economic growth;
  - c. vegetable and animal food security to realize a village without hunger;
  - d. *stunting* prevention to realize a healthy and prosperous Village; and
  - e. development of inclusive villages to increase overall community involvement in village development.
- (3) The use of Village Funds for mitigation and handling of natural and non-natural disasters in accordance with the authority of the Village as referred to in Article 5 paragraph (2) letter c is prioritized for the achievement of the Village *SDGs* :
  - a. natural disaster mitigation and management;
  - b. mitigation and handling of non-natural disasters; and
  - c. realizing a village without poverty through the Village Fund BLT .
- (4) BLT as referred to in paragraph (3) letter c is implemented in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.

### CHAPTER III DETERMINATION OF PRIORITIES FOR THE USE OF VILLAGE FUNDS

#### Article 7

- (1) The determination of priority for the use of the Village Fund as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (3) letter b is discussed and agreed upon through the Village Consultative Assembly for the preparation of the Village RKP.
- (2) The Village Deliberation as referred to in paragraph (1) results in an agreement regarding the priority of using the Village Fund as outlined in the official report.
- (3) The minutes as referred to in paragraph (2) serve as guidelines for the Village Government in the preparation of Village Regulations governing the Village RKP.
- (4) In determining the priority of using the Village Fund as referred to in paragraph (1), it is carried out following the stages of Village development planning in accordance with the Regent's Regulation concerning Village development.

Article 8

- (1) The implementation of programs and/or activities as referred to in Article 5 paragraph (2) is carried out through self-management by utilizing local Village resources.
- (2) Self-management as referred to in paragraph (1) shall be prioritized using the PKTD pattern.
- (3) PKTD funding as referred to in paragraph (2) is allocated for workers' wages of at least 50% (fifty percent) of PKTD activity funds.
- (4) The Village Fund used to fund community capacity development is carried out through self-management by the Village or inter-Village cooperation agency.
- (5) Self-management by inter-Village cooperation bodies as referred to in paragraph (4) is carried out in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.

Article 9

- (1) The implementation of programs and/or activities through self-management as referred to in Article 8 paragraph (1) can be carried out by means of cooperation between Villages and/or Village cooperation with third parties carried out in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.
- (2) In the event that there is a need for cooperation between the Village and the kelurahan to carry out programs and/or activities through self-management as referred to in paragraph (1), it shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.

Article 10

- (1) The Village Community shall participate in determining the priority for the use of the Village Fund.
- (2) Village community participation as referred to in paragraph (1) is carried out by:
  - a. actively involved in each stage of prioritizing the use of the Village Fund;
  - b. submit program and/or activity proposals;
  - c. ensure that the priority of using the Village Fund is determined in the Village RKP and Village APB documents; and
  - d. participate in disseminating the priority of using the Village Fund.
- (3) The Village Government is obliged to involve the community in setting priorities for the use of Village Funds.

Article 11

- (1) Priority for the use of Village Funds shall be part of the Village RKP.
- (2) Priority for the use of Village Funds as referred to in paragraph (1) shall be prepared based on:
  - a. Village SDGs data collection results by the Village;
  - b. data provided by the Ministry; and
  - c. aspirations of the village community.
- (3) The Village RKP containing the priority of using the Village Fund as referred to in paragraph (1) shall serve as a guideline in the preparation of the Village APB.

CHAPTER I V  
PUBLICATIONS AND REPORTING

Part One  
Publication

Article 12

- (1) The Village Government is obliged to publish the determination of priorities for the use of Village Funds.
- (2) The publication as referred to in paragraph (1) consists of:
  - a. the results of the Village Deliberation; and
  - b. Village data, maps of development potential and resources, Village RPJM documents, Village RKP documents, priorities for the use of Village Funds, and Village APB documents.
- (3) The publication of the Village Budget as referred to in paragraph (2) letter b shall at least contain:
  - a. name of activity;
  - b. activity location; and
  - c. budget amount.

Article 13

- (1) The publication as referred to in Article 12 is carried out in a public space that is easily accessible by the Village community.
- (2) The publication of priority setting for the use of Village Funds is carried out in a self-managed and participatory manner.
- (3) In the event that the Village Government does not publish the determination of the priority for the use of the Village Fund in the public space as referred to in paragraph (1), the BPD shall submit an oral and/or written warning.

The second part  
Reporting

Article 14

- (1) The Village Head submits a report on determining the priority of using the Village Fund to the Regent.
- (2) The report on determining the priority of using the Village Fund as referred to in paragraph (1) is in the form of a digital document using the Village Information System provided by the Ministry.
- (3) The submission of the report as referred to in paragraph (1) is carried out no later than 1 (one) month after the Village RKP is stipulated.

CHAPTER V  
COACHING

Article 15

- (1) The Regent provides guidance through socialization, monitoring, and evaluation of priorities for the use of Village Funds in stages.
- (2) Regent in carrying out the guidance as referred to in paragraph (1) can be delegated to the Community and Village Empowerment Service and/or the Camat.
- (3) The guidance as referred to in paragraph (2) can be assisted by Professional Assistance Personnel and third parties in accordance with the provisions of the laws and regulations.

CHAPTER VI  
OTHER PROVISIONS

Article 16

In the event that there is a change in the direction of the Government's new policy or policy, the priority of using the Village Fund is carried out by the Village in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.

Article 17

The financial management of implementing the priority use of the Village Fund is in accordance with the provisions of the laws and regulations governing Village financial management.

CHAPTER VII  
CLOSING

Article 18

This Regent Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.
