**SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUKOHARJO REGENCY REGULATION NUMBER
44 OF 2016 CONCERNING THE ARRANGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL/KLONTONG SHOPS
IN SUKOHARJO DISTRICT**

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering:

a. that in order to make effective enforcement of regional laws and regulations, especially in the context of implementing Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning the Arrangement of Traditional Shops/Klontong in Sukoharjo Regency as amended by Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 32 of 2018 concerning Amendments to Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning Arrangement of Traditional/Klontong Shops in Sukoharjo Regency, then Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning Arrangement of Traditional/Klontong Shops in Sukoharjo Regency as amended by Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 32 of 2018 concerning Amendments to Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning The arrangement of traditional/clontong shops in Sukoharjo Regency needs to be changed;

b. that based on the considerations as intended in letter a, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation concerning the Second Amendment to the Regent's Regulation Sukoharjo Number 44 of 2016 concerning Arrangement of Traditional Shops/Klontong in Sukoharjo Regency;

DECIDE :

To stipulate: SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUKOHARJO REGENCY REGULATION NUMBER 44 OF 2016 CONCERNING THE ARRANGEMENT OF TRADITIONAL/CLONTONG SHOPS IN SUKOHARJO DISTRICT.

Article I

Provisions of Article 16 in the Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning Store Arrangement Traditional/Grocery in Sukoharjo Regency (News Sukoharjo Regency Region of 2016 Number 44) as amended by the Regent's Regulation Sukoharjo Number 32 of 2018 concerning Top Amendments Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 44 of 2016 concerning Arrangement of Traditional/Grocery Stores in the Regency Sukoharjo (Sukoharjo Regency Regional News Year 2018 Number 32) is amended to read as follows:

Article 16

- (1) Any Traditional Shop/Grocery business operator who violates the provisions of this Regent's Regulation may be subject to administrative sanctions.**
- (2) Administrative sanctions as intended in paragraph (1) can be in the form of: a.
written warning; b.
closing/sealing; and/or
c. license revocation.**
- (3) The imposition of administrative sanctions in the form of written warnings as intended in paragraph (2) letter a is carried out by giving a written warning to the owner/manager/ person in charge of the Traditional/Grocery Shop.**
- (4) The imposition of administrative sanctions in the form of closure/sealing as referred to in paragraph (2) letter b can be implemented without being preceded by a written warning.**

- (5) In the event that the imposition of administrative sanctions in the form of closure/sealing as intended in paragraph (2) letter b is preceded by a written warning, then the closure/sealing is carried out no sooner than 1 (one) day after the written warning is given.
- (6) The imposition of closing/sealing sanctions as intended in paragraph (2) letter b can be marked in the form of:
- a. installation of bylaw line signs;
 - b. installation of warnings has not been permitted; and/or
 - c. another form.
- (7) The Civil Service Police Unit and/or together with the Team can close traditional/grocery shops accompanied by sealing and installing warning boards.
- (8) The imposition of administrative sanctions in the form of revocation of permits as intended in paragraph (2) letter c is carried out in accordance with the provisions of statutory regulations.

Article II

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

So that everyone is aware, this regulation is ordered to be promulgated with its placement in the ~~Regent's~~ Regional News of Sukoharjo Regency.
