PROCEDURES FOR COMPANY REGISTRATION

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

REGENT SUKOHARJO,

Considering: a. that in order to accelerate and increase investment and business, it is necessary to re-arrange the provisions regarding company registration procedures as regulated in Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 10 of 2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Company Registration Certificates;

b. that with the enactment of Minister of Trade Regulation Number 76 of 2018 concerning the Implementation of Company Registration, Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 10 of 2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Company Registration Certificates needs to be replaced;

c. that based on the considerations as intended in letters a and b, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent's Regulation on Procedures for Company Registration;

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent's Regulation what is meant by:

1. The region is Sukoharjo Regency.
2. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
3. Regional Government is the Regent as the organizing element of the Regional Government which leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
4. Company Register is a list of official records held in accordance with or based on the provisions of Law Number 3 of 1982 concerning Compulsory Company Registration and/or its implementing regulations and contains matters that must be registered by every company and ratified by authorized officials.
5. Electronically Integrated Business Licensing or *Online Single Submission* , hereinafter abbreviated as OSS, is a business permit issued by the OSS Institution for and on behalf of ministers, heads of institutions, governors, or regents/mayors to business actors through an integrated electronic system.
6. Registration is the registration of business and/or activities by business actors through OSS.
7. OSS Management and Organizing Institutions, hereinafter referred to as OSS Institutions, are non-ministerial government institutions that carry out government affairs in the field of investment coordination.



8. Company Registration Certificate, hereinafter abbreviated as TDP, is a certificate of validation given by the OSS Institution to business actors who have registered.
9. Business Identification Number, hereinafter abbreviated as NIB, is the identity of the business actor issued by the OSS Institution after the business actor has registered.
10. Company Representative is a company that acts on behalf of the company's head office to carry out activities and/or management in accordance with the specified authority.

CHAPTER II

REGISTRATION OBLIGATIONS

Section 2

Every company in the form of a Limited Liability Company (PT), Cooperative, Limited Partnership (CV), Firma (Fa), Individual, and other forms of business, including Foreign Companies with Company Representative status domiciled and carrying out their business in the territory of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia must be registered in the company register.

CHAPTER III

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Article 3

- (1) Company registration as intended in Article 2 is carried out through OSS.
- (2) Registration as intended in paragraph (1) by means of access the OSS page.
- (3) How to access the OSS page as intended in paragraph (1) is by entering:
 - a. NIK in the event that the Business Actor is an individual;
 - b. approval number for the deed of establishment or registration number for a limited liability company, foundation/business entity established by a foundation, cooperative, limited partnership (commanditaire vennootschap), firm partnership (venootschap onder firm), or civil partnership;
 - c. legal basis for the formation of public companies, regional public companies, other legal entities owned by the state, public broadcasting institutions, or public service agencies.



- (4) Individual business actors who have gained access to the OSS page must register by filling in the following data:
- a. name and NIK;
 - b. address;
 - c. business fields;
 - d. investment location;
 - e. the amount of capital investment plans;
 - f. workforce utilization plan;
 - g. business and/or activity contact number;
 - h. planning requests for fiscal facilities, customs, and/or other facilities; And
 - i. NPWP of individual Business Actors.
- (5) Non-individual business actors who have gained access to the OSS page must register by filling in at least the following data:
- a. name and/or approval number for the deed of establishment or registration number;
 - b. business fields;
 - c. type of capital investment;
 - d. country of origin of investment, in the event that there is foreign investment;
 - e. investment location;
 - f. the amount of capital investment plans;
 - g. workforce utilization plan;
 - h. business entity contact number;
 - i. plan to request tax, customs and/or other facilities;
 - j. NPWP of non-individual Business Actors; and K. NIK of the person responsible for the business and/or activity.

Article 4

- (1) Business actors who have registered a company as intended in Article 3 receive an NIB which is valid as a TDP.
- (2) NIB as TDP is valid for the validity period NIB.
- (3) The authority to issue NIB as intended in paragraph (1) rests with the OSS Institution.

Article 5

Every business actor who makes changes to registered company data is required to report data changes through the OSS system.



CHAPTER IV
TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS
Article 6

Business actors who have registered their company based on Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 10 of 2017 Concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Registration Certificates Companies are required to register companies in accordance with the provisions of this Sukoharjo Regent Regulation no later than 2 (two) years from the Sukoharjo Regent Regulation this is promulgated.

CHAPTER V
CLOSING
Article 7

When this Regent's Regulation comes into force, Sukoharjo Regent's Regulation Number 10 of 2017 concerning Procedures and Requirements for Issuing Company Registration Certificates (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2017 Number 10) is revoked and declared invalid.

Article 8

This Regent's Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.
