REGULATION OF THE REGENT OF SUKOHARJO NUMBER 34 YEAR 20 21

ABOUT

DELEGATION AUTHORITY OF BUSINESS LICENSING, NON-BUSINESS LICENSING AND NON- PERMISSIONS TO HEAD SERVICE ONE DOOR INTEGRATED INVESTMENT AND SERVICE

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY SUKOHARJO REGENT,

Weigh

- : a. that according to the provisions of Article 5 Government Regulation Number 6 of 2021 concerning the Implementation of Business Licensing in the Regions states that the District Head delegates the authority of the Regency Regional Government in the Implementation of Business Licensing in the Regions to the Head of the Office of Capital Investment and Integrated Services . K district;
 - b. that Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 50 of 2020 concerning Delegation of Authority in the Licensing and Non-licensing Sector to the Head of the Sukoharjo Regency Investment and One-Stop Integrated Service Office is no longer in accordance with the provisions of the legislation so it needs to be replaced;
 - c. that based on the considerations as referred to in letters a, b and c, it is necessary to stipulate a Regent Regulation concerning the Delegation of Authority for Business Licensing, Non-Business Licensing and Non-Licensing to the Head of the Investment Service and One Stop Services;

: REGULATION OF THE REGENT REGARDING THE DELEGATION OF AUTHORITIES FOR BUSINESS LICENSING, NON-BUSINESS LICENSING AND NON- PERMISSIONS TO THE HEAD OF THE HEAD OF INVESTMENT AND ONE-DOOR INTEGRATED SERVICES.

PIG GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent Regulation, what is meant by:

- 1. The area is Sukoharjo Regency.
- 2. Regional Government is the Regent as an element of the Regional Government organizer who leads the implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
- 3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
- 4. The Office of Investment and One Stop Integrated Services, hereinafter referred to as Dinas PM and PTSP, is the Office of Investment and One Stop Integrated Services of Sukoharjo Regency.
- 5. One-Stop Integrated Service, hereinafter abbreviated as PTSP, is an integrated service in a single process starting from the application stage to the completion stage of the one-stop integrated service product.
- 6. Delegation of Authority is the assignment of duties, rights,

- obligations, and responsibilities for business and non-business licensing, including services on behalf of the authorizing authority.
- 7. Implementation of Business Licensing in the Regions is a business licensing activity whose management process is electronically starting from the application stage to the issuance of documents which are carried out in an integrated manner in one door.
- 8. License is a legality granted to Business Actors to start and run their business and/or activities.
- 9. Risk is the potential for injury or loss from a hazard or a combination of the possibilities and consequences of a hazard.
- 10. Risk-Based Business Licensing is a Business Licensing based on the level of business activity Risk.
- 11. Business Licensing to Support Business Activities is a legality granted to Business Actors to support business activities.
- 12. The Electronically Integrated Business Licensing System (Online Single Submission), hereinafter referred to as the OSS System, is an integrated electronic system managed and organized by the OSS Institution for the implementation of Risk-Based Business Licensing.
- 13. OSS Management and Organizing Agency, hereinafter referred to as OSS Institution, is a government agency that carries out Government Affairs in the field of investment coordination.
- 14. Business Actors are individuals or business entities conducting business and/or activities in certain fields.
- 15. Business Registration Number, hereinafter abbreviated as NIB, is proof of registration/registration of Business Actor to carry out business activities and as an identity for Business Actor in carrying out their business activities.
- 16. Standard Certificate is a statement and/or proof of compliance with the standards for the implementation of business activities.
- 17. License is the approval of the Central Government or Regional Government for the implementation of business activities that must be fulfilled by Business Actors before carrying out their business activities.
- 18. No license number is the provision of documents or proof of the legality of something to a person or group of people for the convenience of service and information in accordance with the provisions of the legislation .
- 19. Electronic Document is any electronic information created, forwarded, sent, received, or stored in analog, digital, electromagnetic, optical, or similar forms, which can be seen, displayed, and/or heard through a computer or electronic system, including but not limited to on writing, sounds, pictures, maps, designs, photographs or the like, letters, signs,

- numbers, access codes, symbols or perforations that have meaning or meaning or can be understood by people who able to understand it.
- 20. Electronic Signature is a signature consisting of Electronic Information that is attached, associated or related to other Electronic Information which is used as a means of verification and authentication.

Section 2

The scope of regulation in this Regent Regulation includes:

- a. delegating authority;
- b. responsibility, guidance and supervision; and
- c. coordination and reporting.

CHAPTER II

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

Article 3

- (1) The Regent delegates authority in the Administration of Licensing in the Regions to the Head of the PM and PTSP Service Offices .
- (2) delegation of authority by the bupati as referred to in paragraph (1) includes:
 - a. business license;
 - b. non-business licensing; and
 - c. non-licensed.
- (3) Business licensing as referred to in paragraph (2) letter a, is implemented through the OSS System which is managed by the Central Government in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations regarding the implementation of business licensing.
- (4) Non-business licensing and non licensing as referred to in paragraph (2) letter b and letter c , are permits regulated in the laws and regulations in Indonesia. outside of business licensing which is carried out through a system facilitated by the Region .

Article 4

Types of business licensing services, non-business licensing and non-licensing which are delegated to the Head of the PM and PTSP Service Offices as referred to in Article 3 are listed in the Appendix which is an integral part of this Regent's Regulation.

Article 5

(1) delegation of authority for business licensing as referred to in Article 3 includes:

- a. administering Business Licensing which is the authority of the Region in accordance with the provisions of the legislation;
- b. administering Business Licensing which is the authority of the Central Government which is delegated to the Regions based on the principle of co-administration;
- c. Risk-Based Business Licensing in each sector is supervised by the Regent;
- d. issue Business Standard Certificates and Product Standard Certificates based on the results of verification of standard compliance;
- e. perform verification;
- f. conduct examination of the requirements for Business Licensing according to the time period;
- g. granting a Business License in accordance with the validity period;
- h. implementation of the issuance of Business Licensing; and/or
- i. resolve obstacles and problems in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.
- (2) In addition to the delegation of authority as referred to in P origin 3, the Regent grants authority to the Head of the PM and PTSP Service in terms of:
 - a. providing information on licensing and non-licensing services;
 - b. p acceptance and n/or rejection of application files;
 - c. issuance of licensing and non-licensing documents;
 - d. revocation and cancellation of permits and non-licenses;
 - e. k coordination of research or field inspection;
 - f. storage and processing of electronic data archives;
 - g. development of information on licensing and non-licensing services;

- h. handling of complaints on licensing and non-licensing services;
- i. coordinating the handling of complaints and reporting on the follow-up to complaints; and
- j. complaint system management.

CHAPTER I II

RESPONSIBILITY, DEVELOPMENT AND SUPERVISION

Article 6

- (1) In administering Business Licensing, Non-Business Licensing and Non-licensing, the Head of the PM and PTSP Service is administratively responsible while the technical responsibility rests with the regional apparatus in charge.
- (2) Regional apparatus in charge of providing guidance in accordance with their respective authorities based on the provisions of laws and regulations.
- (3) The guidance as referred to in paragraph (2) can be in the form of facilitation, consultation, socialization, monitoring, evaluation, technical guidance and development.

Article 7

- (1) The Regional Apparatus in charge and the Civil Service Police Unit carry out supervision in accordance with their respective authorities based on the provisions of the legislation.
- (2) The supervision as referred to in paragraph (1) may take the form of inspections from time to time in the field to ensure the conformity of business activities with licensing.
- (3) Supervision and evaluation after the issuance of permits and non-licenses is carried out and becomes the responsibility of the Regional Apparatus in charge in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.

CHAPTER I V

COORDINATION AND REPORTING

Article 8

- (1) In carrying out their duties, the Head of the PM and PTSP Services coordinates with the agencies and/or Regional Apparatuses in charge of licensing and non-licensing.
- (2) In carrying out the delegation of authority as referred to in Article 3, the Head of the PM and PTSP Service reports to the Regent.

CHAPTER V CLOSING

At the time this Regent Regulation comes into force, the Sukoharjo Regent Regulation Number 50 of 20 20 concerning Delegation of Authority in Licensing and Non-licensing Sector to the Head of the Sukoharjo Regency Investment and One Stop Integrated Service Office (Sukoharjo Regency Regional Gazette of 2020 Number 50), is revoked and declared not applicable.
