SUKOHARJO REGENT,

 Weigh : that based on the provisions of Article 19 paragraph (1) of the Regulation of the Minister of Finance Number 222/PMK.07/2020 concerning Village Fund Management , it is necessary to stipulate a Regent Regulation concerning Procedures for Distribution and Determination of Details Every Village Fund Villages in Sukoharjo Regency for Financial Year 2021;

: **REGULATION** OF THE REGENT REGARDING PROCEDURES FOR DISTRIBUTION AND DETERMINATION OF DETAILS OF VILLAGE FUNDS IN EVERY VILLAGE IN SUKOHARJO REGENCY FOR FINANCIAL YEAR N 2021.

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GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

article 1

In this Regent Regulation, what is meant by:

- 1. The area is Sukoharjo Regency.
- 2. Regional Government is the Regent as an element of leads government organizer who the regional implementation of government affairs which are the authority of the autonomous region.
- 3. The Regent is the Regent of Sukoharjo.
- 4. The village is a legal community unit that has territorial boundaries that are authorized to regulate and manage government affairs, the interests of the local community based on community initiatives, origin rights, and/or traditional rights that are recognized and respected in the government system of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.
- 5. Village Funds are funds sourced from the State Revenue and Expenditure Budget designated for Villages which are transferred through the district/city Regional Revenue and Expenditure Budget and are used to finance administration, implementation government development, construction society, and community empowerment.
- 6. The Village Government is the Village Head assisted by the Village apparatus as an element of the Village Administration;
- 7. Number of Villages is the number of Villages determined by the Minister of Home Affairs .
- 8. Village Revenue and Expenditure Budget, hereinafter referred to as APBDesa, is the annual financial plan of the Village Government.

CHAPTER II

PROCEDURE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF VILLAGE FUND DETAILS

Section 2

Details of the Village Fund for each Village in Sukoharjo Regency Fiscal Year 2021 allocated equitably and fairly based on:

- a. basic allocation for each village ;
- b. affirmation allocation for each village ;

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- c. allocation of performance for each village ; and
- d. allocation formula for each village .

Article 3

- (1) The basic allocation of each village as referred to in Article 2 letter a, is determined based on population clusters with the following provisions:
 - a. Rp481,573,000.00 (four hundred eighty-one million five hundred and seventy-three thousand rupiah) for a Village with a population of up to 100 (one hundred) people;
 - b. Rp561,574,000.00 (five hundred sixty-one million five hundred and seventy-four thousand rupiah) for a Village with a population of up to 101 (one hundred and one) up to 1,000 (one thousand) people;
 - c. Rp641,574,000.00 (six hundred forty-one million five hundred and seventy-four thousand rupiah) for a Village with a population of up to 1,001 (one thousand and one) up to 5,000 (five thousand) people;
 - d. Rp.721,575,000.00 (seven hundred twenty-one million five hundred and seventy-five thousand rupiah) for a Village with a population of up to 5,001 (five thousand one) up to 10,000 (ten thousand) people; and
 - e. Rp.801,576,000.00 (eight hundred and one million five hundred and seventy-six thousand rupiah) for a Village with a population of over 10,000 (ten thousand) people.
- (2) The amount of the basic allocation for each village as referred to in paragraph (1), is based on data from the Minister of Finance cq. Director General of Fiscal Balance.

Article 4

- (1) The Affirmation Allocation for each Village as referred to in Article 2 letter b is given to Disadvantaged Villages and Very Disadvantaged Villages which have a high number of poor people.
- (2) The amount of Affirmation Allocation for each Village as referred to in paragraph (1) is calculated based on the provisions in the Regulation of the Minister of Finance regarding Procedures for Allocating Village Funds.
- (3) List of villages receiving the Affirmation Allocation for each village as referred to in paragraph (1), based on data from the Minister of Finance cq. Director General of Fiscal Balance.

Article 5

- (1) Performance allocation for each village as referred to in Article 2 letter c , given to villages that did not receive the Affirmation Allocation with the best performance assessment in village financial management, Village Fund management, Village Fund output achievements, and village development outcomes.
- (2) The list of villages receiving the Performance Allocation for each village as referred to in paragraph (1), based on data from the Minister of Finance cq. Director General of Fiscal Balance.

chapter 6

The calculation of the performance allocation for each Village as referred to in P origin 5 is carried out using the following weights:

- a. village financial management with a weight of 20% (twenty percent);
- b. Village Fund management with a weight of 20% (twenty percent);
- c. Village Fund output achievement with a weighting of 25% (twenty five percent) ; and
- d. achievement of village development results with a weight of 35% (thirty five percent) .

chapter 7

- (1) The management of village finances as referred to in Article 6 letter a is assessed from the change in the ratio of the original Village income to the total APBDesa income and the ratio of spending on development and empowerment to the APBDesa sector.
- (2) management of village funds as referred to in Article 6 letter b is assessed from the percentage of conformity in the development and empowerment fields as a priority of the Village Fund to the total Village Fund and the percentage of village fund goods and services procurement on a self-managed basis.
- (3) The achievement of the Village Fund output as referred to in Article 6 letter c is assessed from the percentage of realization of Village Fund absorption and the percentage of Village Fund output achievement.
- (4) achievement of village development results as referred to in Article 6 letter d is assessed from changes in the scores of the Developing Village Index , changes in the status of the Villages in the Developing Village Index , the status of the last Villages in the Developing Village Index , and improvements in the number of poor people in the village .

Article 8

The amount of the formula allocation for each village as referred to in Article 2 letter d , calculated with the following weights and calculations:

- a. 10% (ten percent) for the total population ;
- b. 40% (forty percent) for the poverty rate ;
- c. 20% (twenty percent) for the area of ; and
- d. 30% (thirty percent) for the geographical difficulty level .

Article 9

The amount of the Formula Allocation for each Village as referred to in the original P is 8 calculated using the following formula :

AF Village = $\{(0,10 \text{ x } Z1) + (0, 4 0 \text{ x } Z2) + (0, 20 \text{ x } Z3) + (0.30 \text{ x } Z4)\} \text{ x AF Kab}$

Information:

AF Village	= Allocation Formula for each Village
Z1	 the ratio of the population of each village to the total population of the village of Sukoharjo district
Z2	= the ratio of the number of poor people in each village to the total poor population of the village of Sukoharjo district
Z3	= ratio of the area of each village to the total area of the village of Sukoharjo district
Z4	 the ratio of the Geographical Difficulty Index of each Village to the Geographical Difficulty Index of each village Village of Sukoharjo district
AF Kab	= Formula Allocation for Sukoharjo Regency

CHAPTER III

DETERMINATION OF VILLAGE FUND DETAILS

Article 10

Determination of Village Fund Details for each Village in Sukoharjo Regency Budget Year 20 21 as listed in the Appendix which is an integral part of this Regent's Regulation.

Article 11
